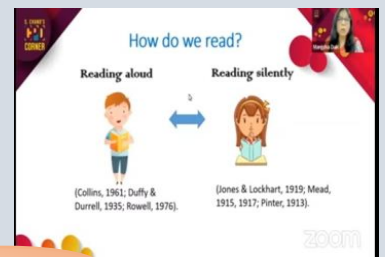
## WORKSHOP ON 'SUBSKILLS OF READING'

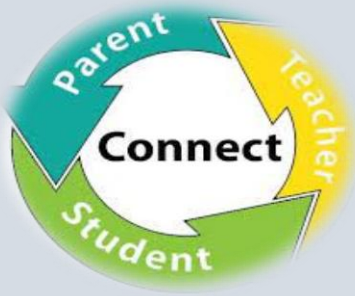


**WORKSHOP ON IAYP BY IAYP GOLD AWARDEES & LEADERS
