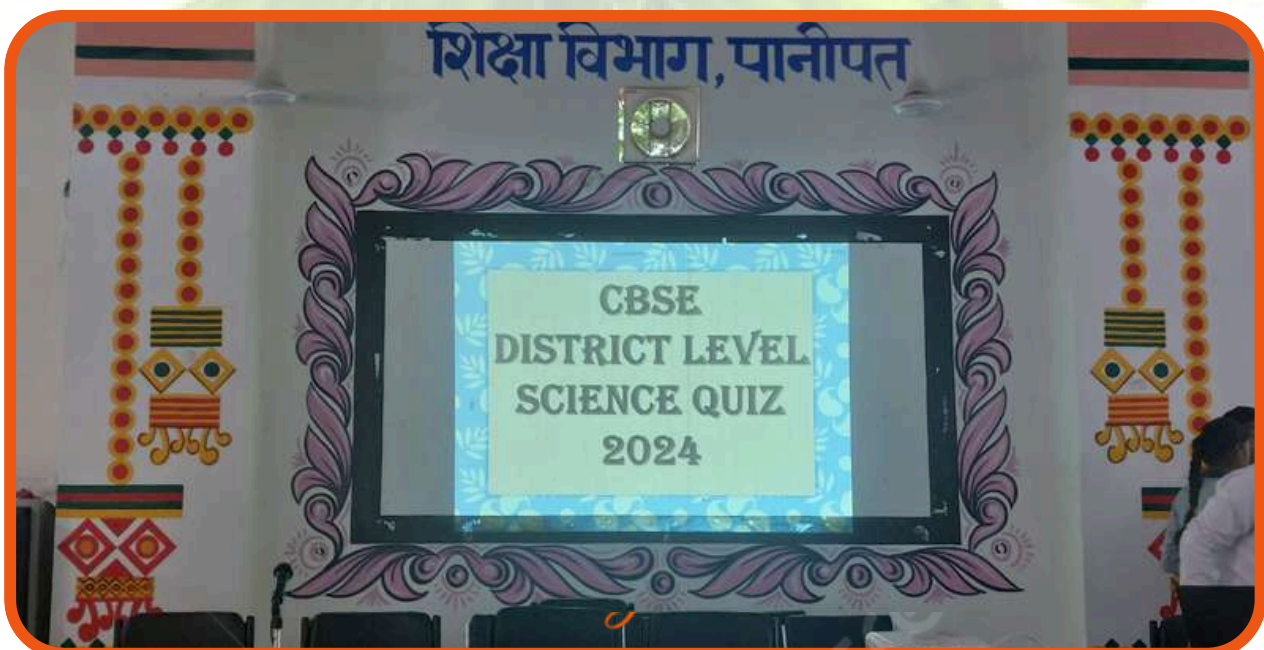

TEEJ CELEBRATION (AUGUST 6, 2024)

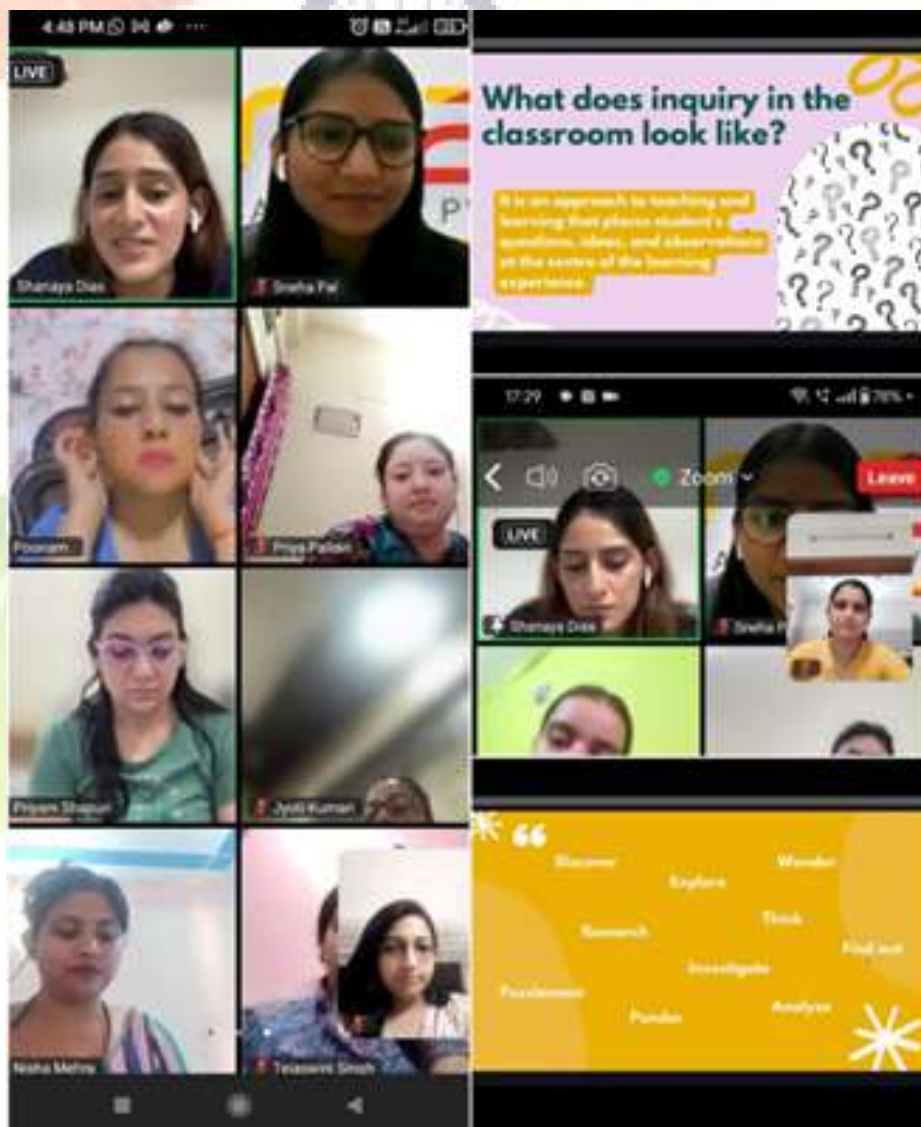
