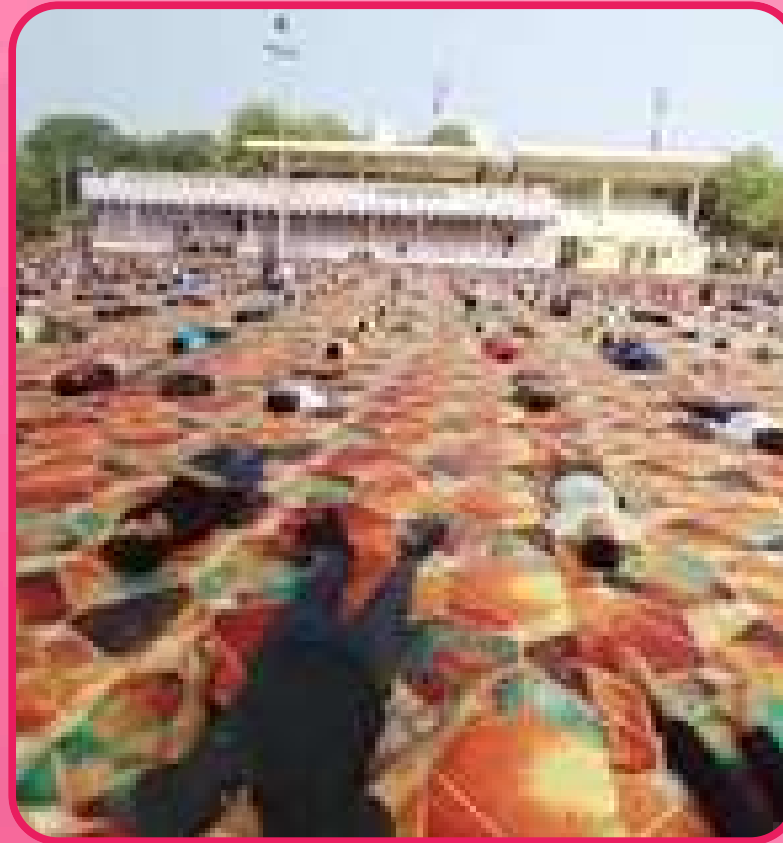


FATHER'S DAY (June 16, 2024).

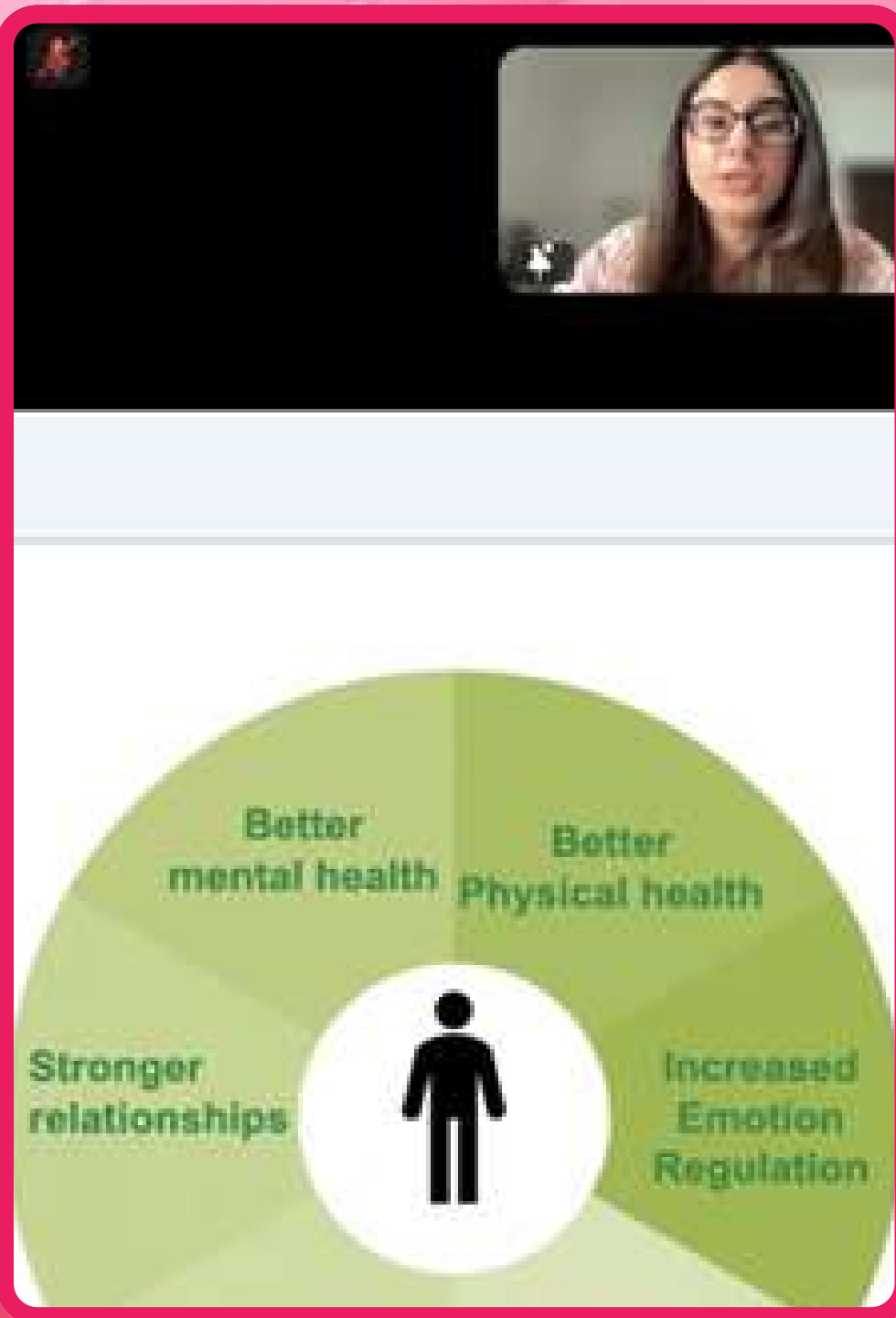


WEBINAR ON SAFETY OF CHILDREN AT SCHOOL (June 29, 2024)

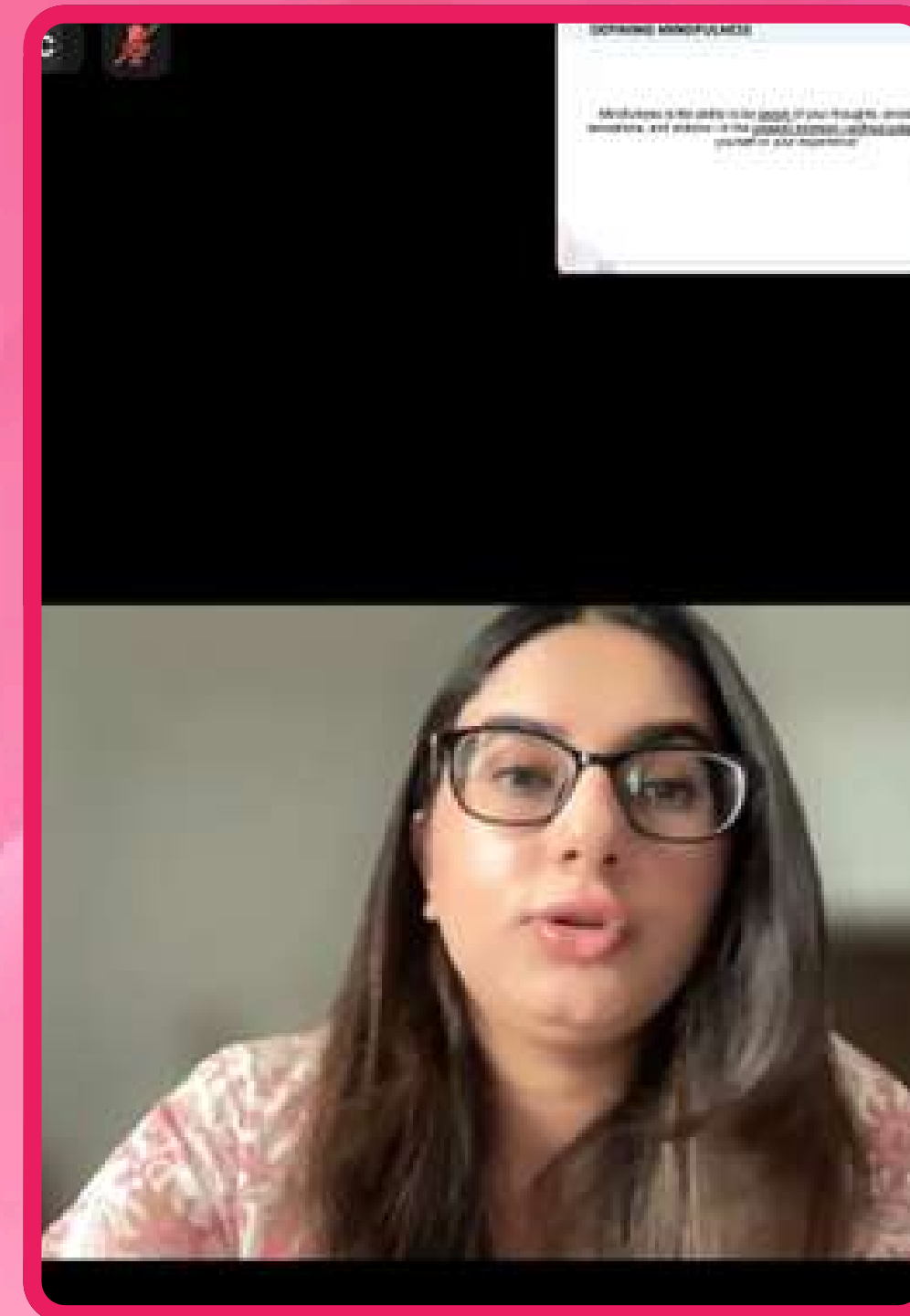

WEBINAR ON MINDFUL LIFESTYLE (June 29, 2024)

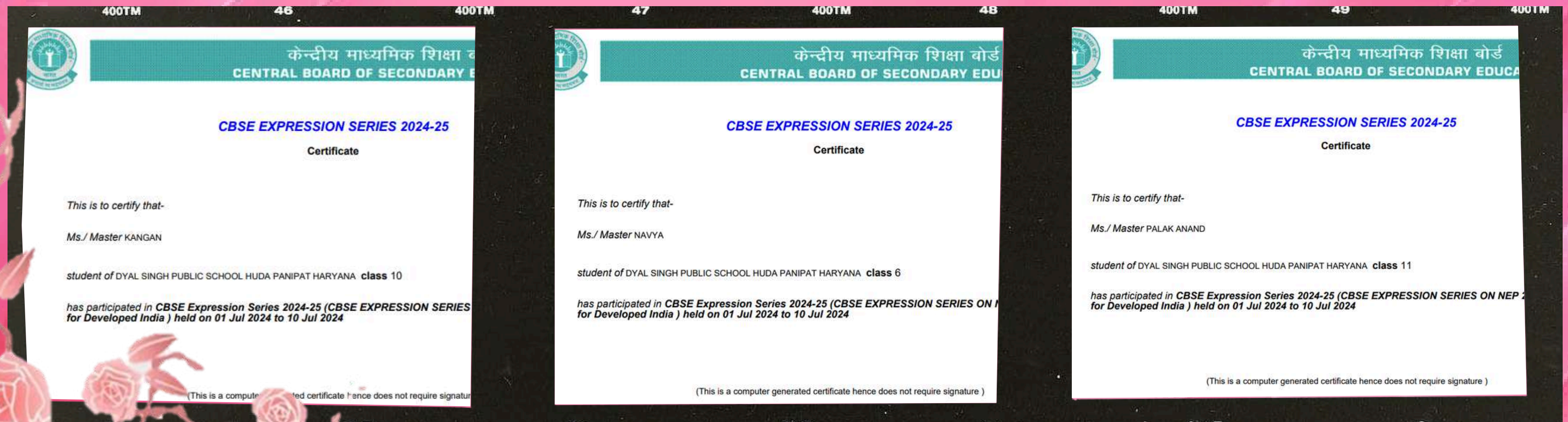

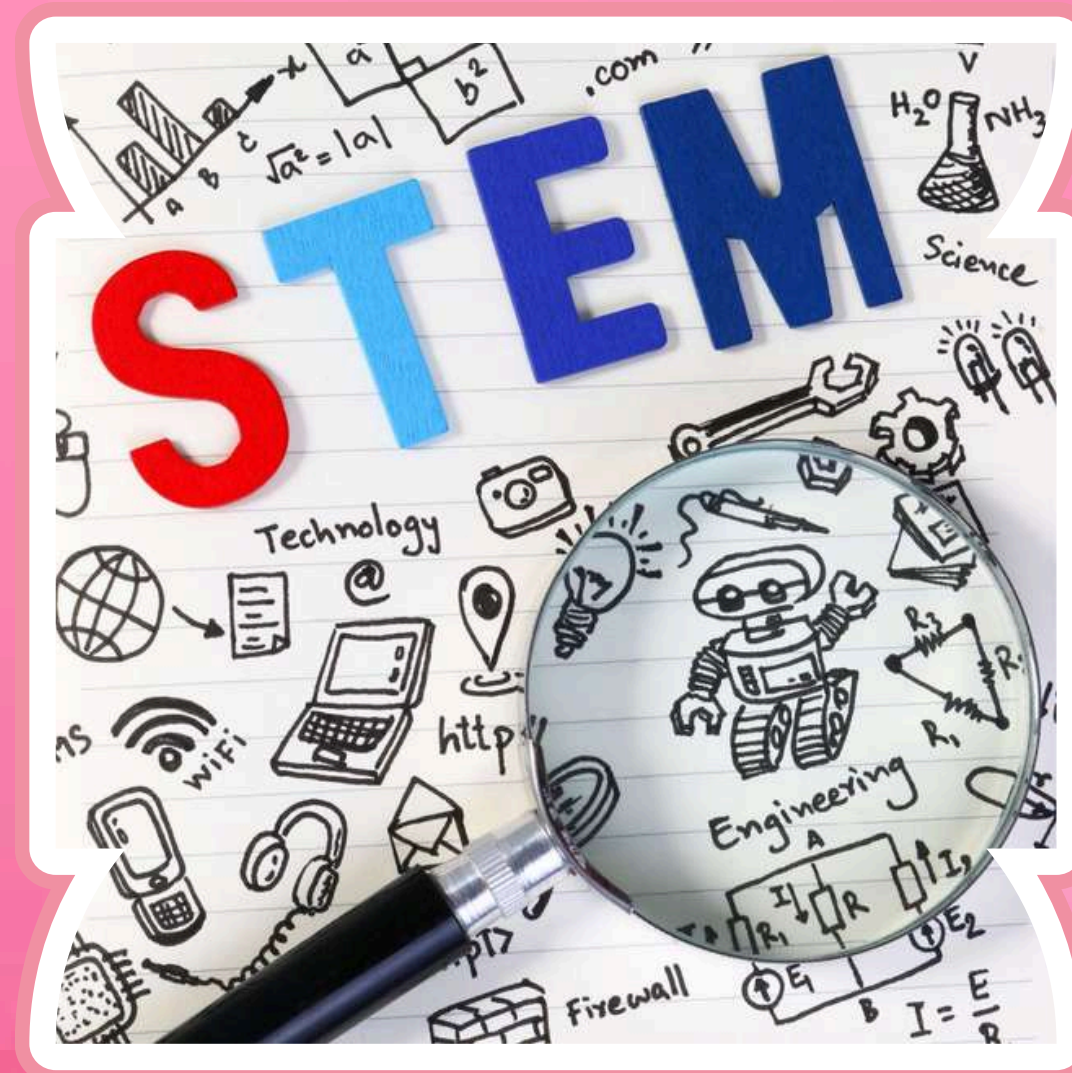
TOWER BUILDING STEM ACTIVITY (July 5, 2024).

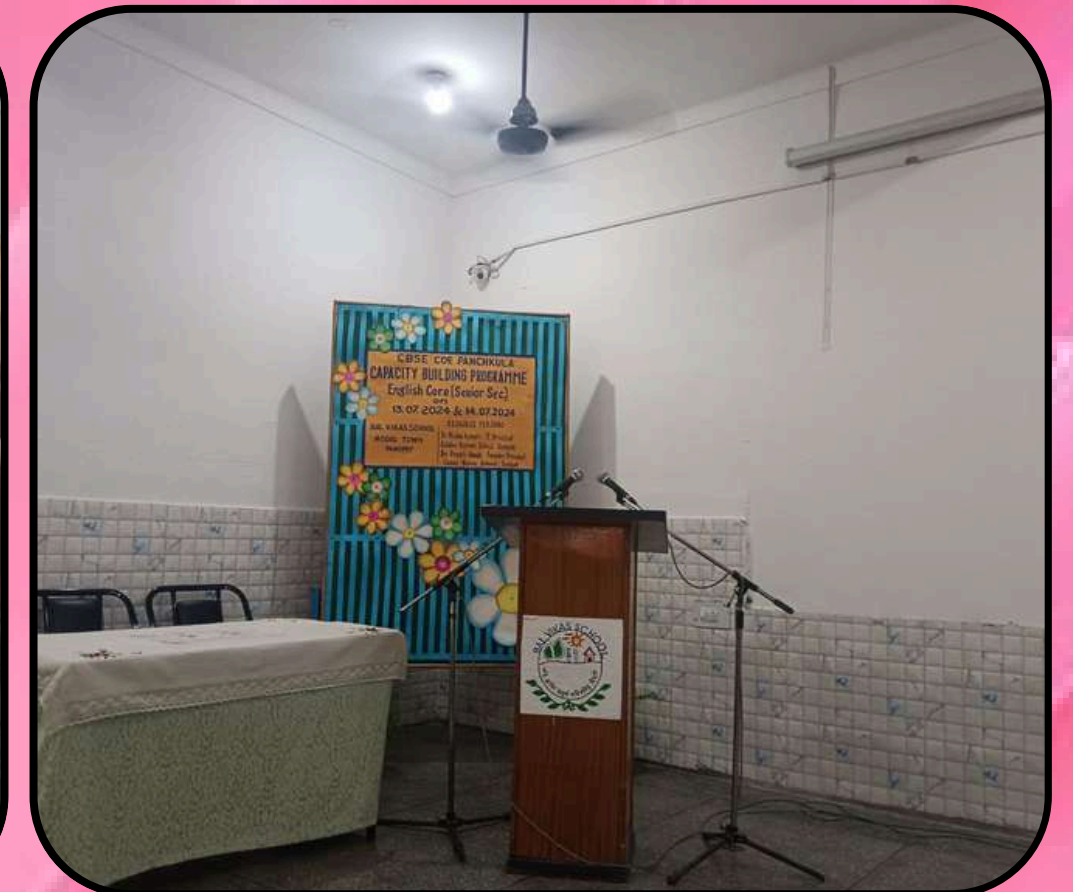
BASTILLE DAY CELEBRATION (July 12, 2024)

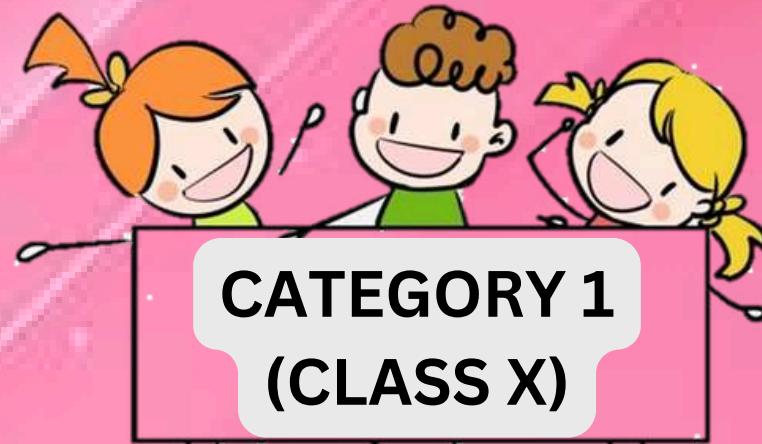
