Two possible ways to do the test – which option would work best for your learners?



1. Do the Listening, and Reading and Writing paper on the same day and the Speaking test on a different day.

2. Do the mock test paper by paper over different days or weeks. For example:

- **Week one:** Listening paper/check answers in class
- **Week two:** Reading and Writing paper/check answers in class
- **Week three:** Speaking test/overall feedback and study goals

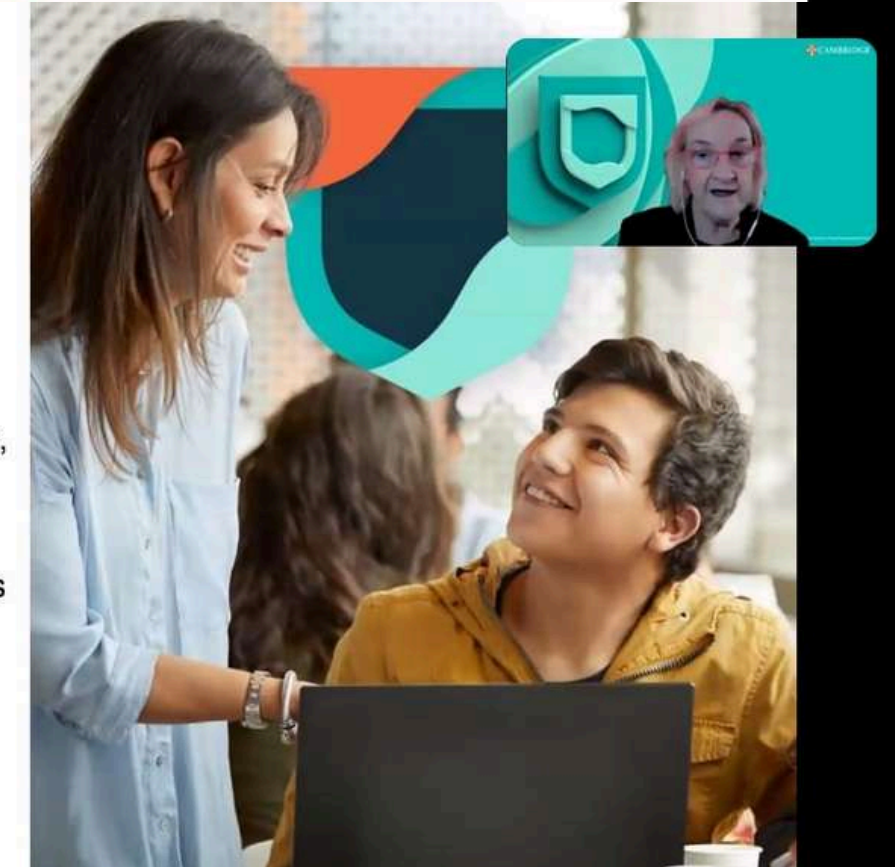

(October 18, 2024)

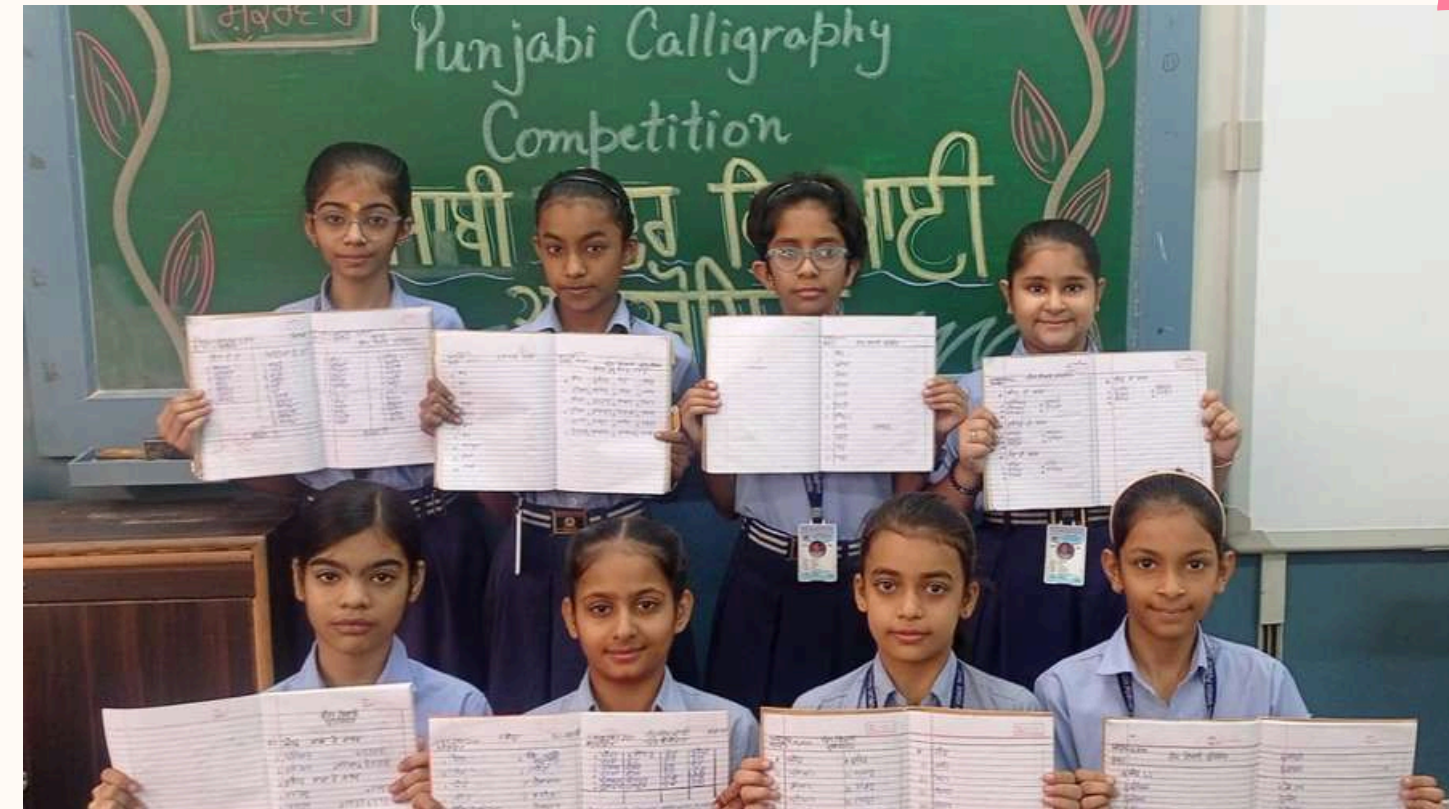

(October 18, 2024)

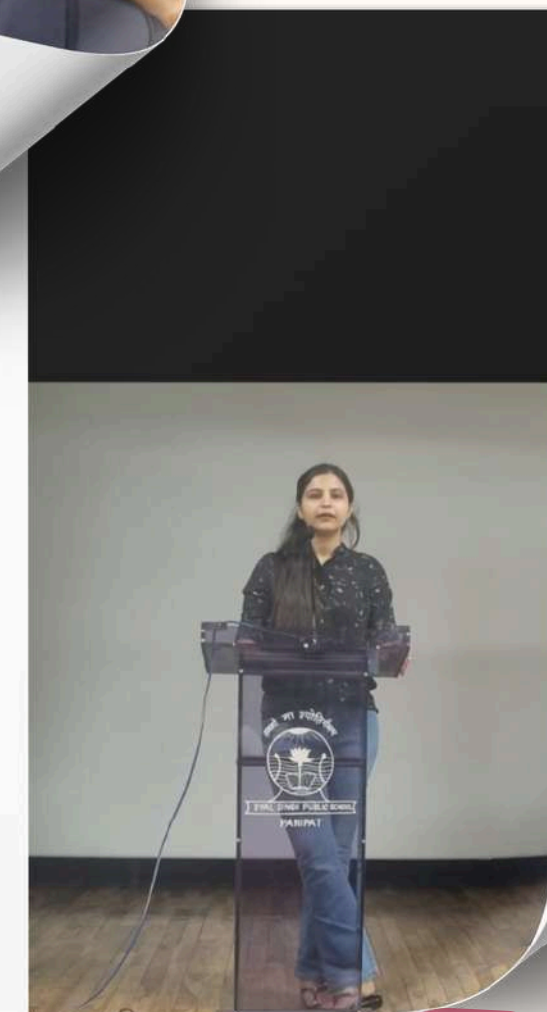

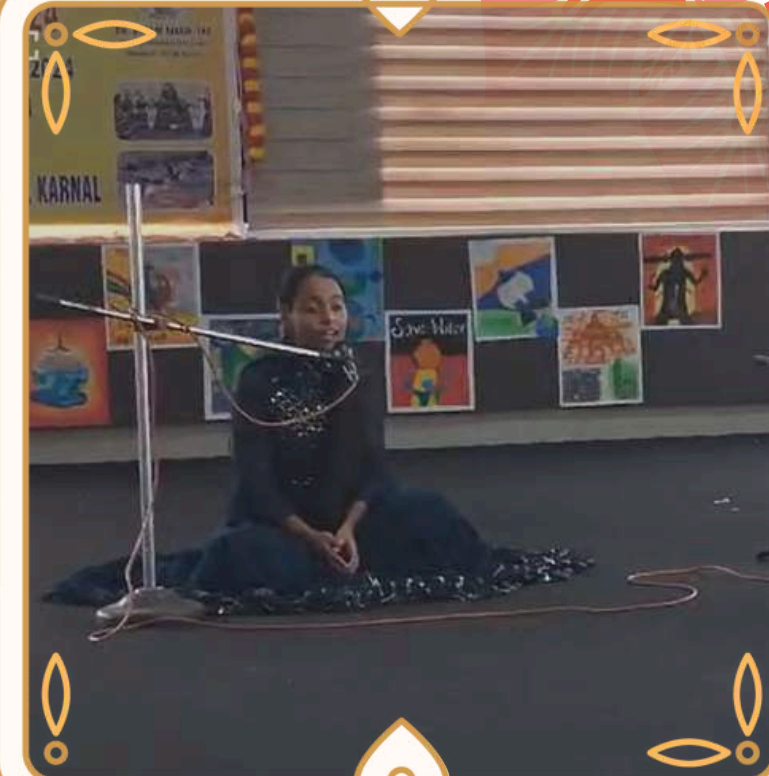

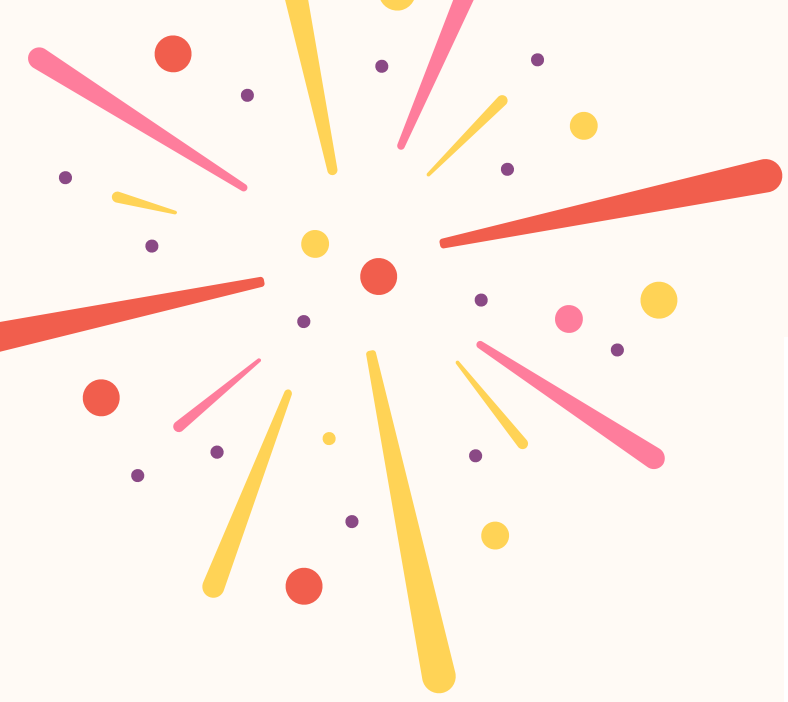


We got **4th Position** in U-19 Basketball Girls in SGFI Tournaments held at Mohana (Sonipat)
