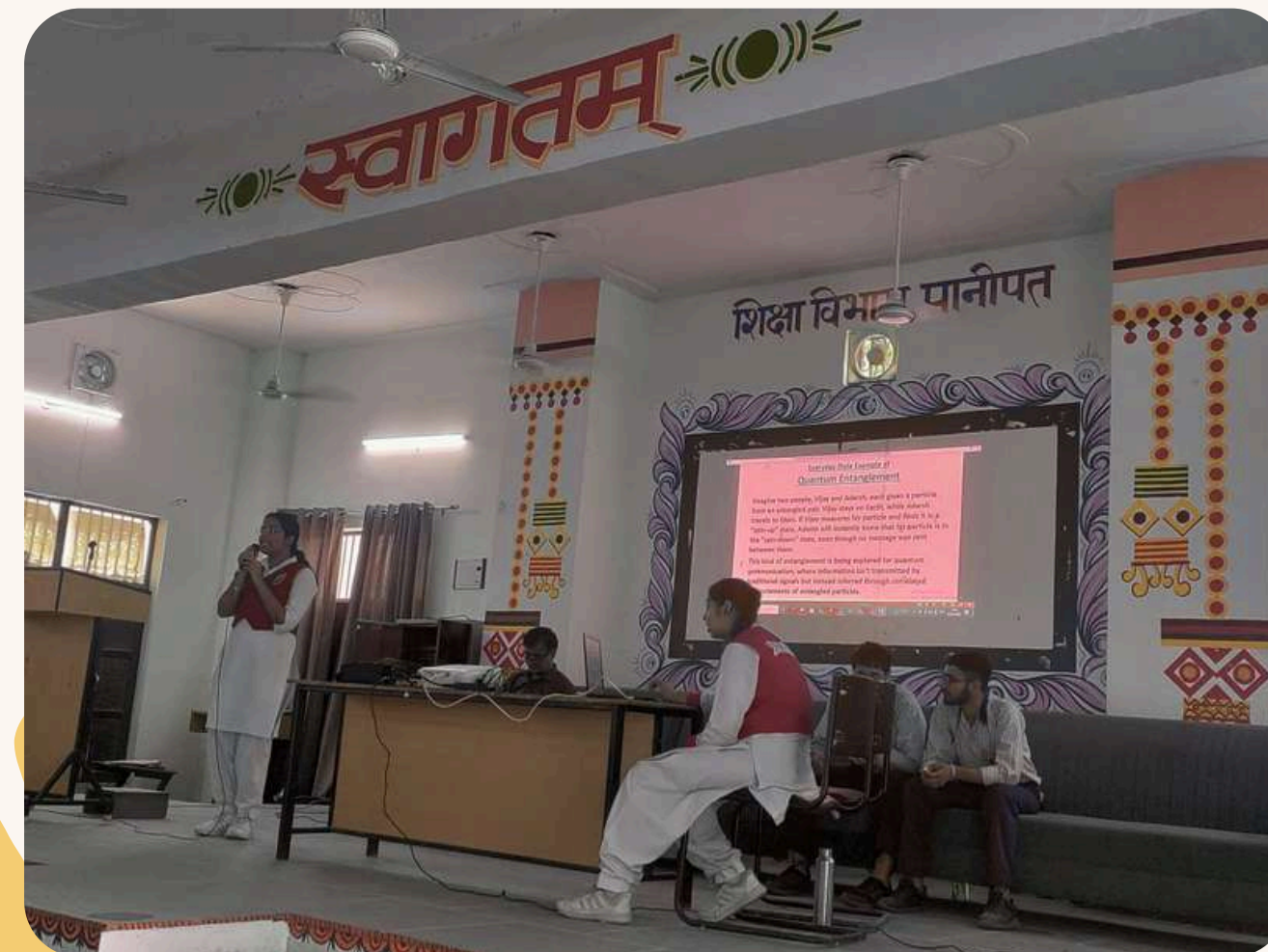


Block Level Science Seminar 2025–26

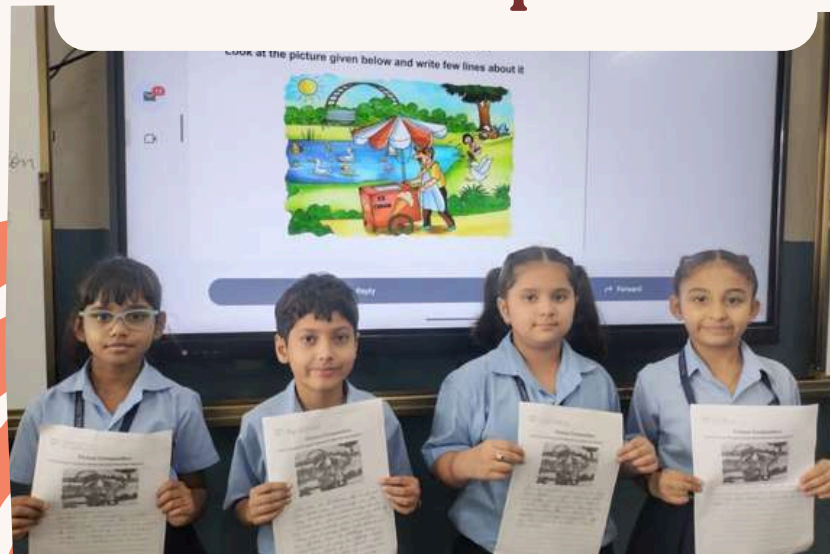
Engaging English Activities

August 12-14 , 2025

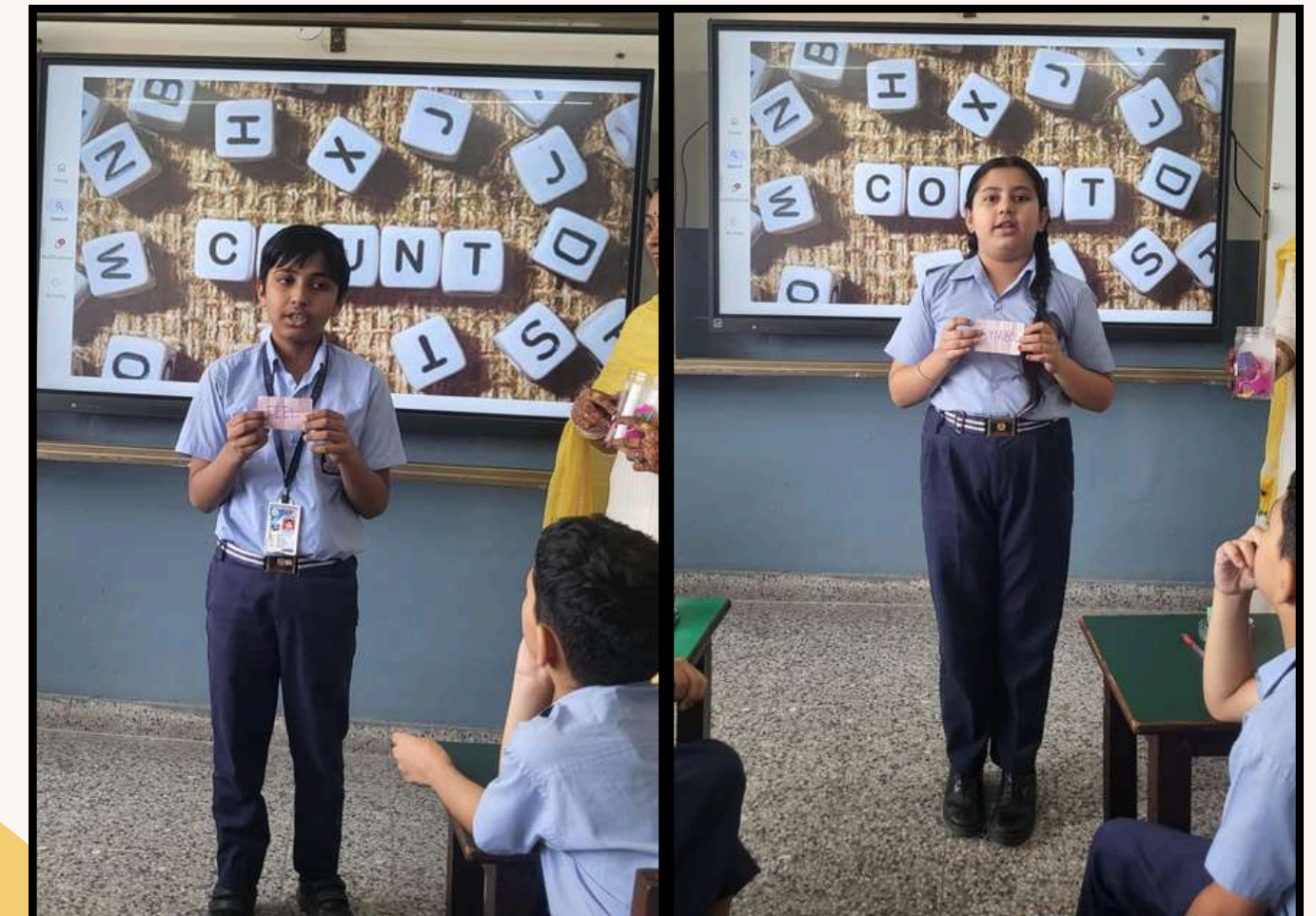

Class Show - 'Shri Krishna Prem aur Prerna'

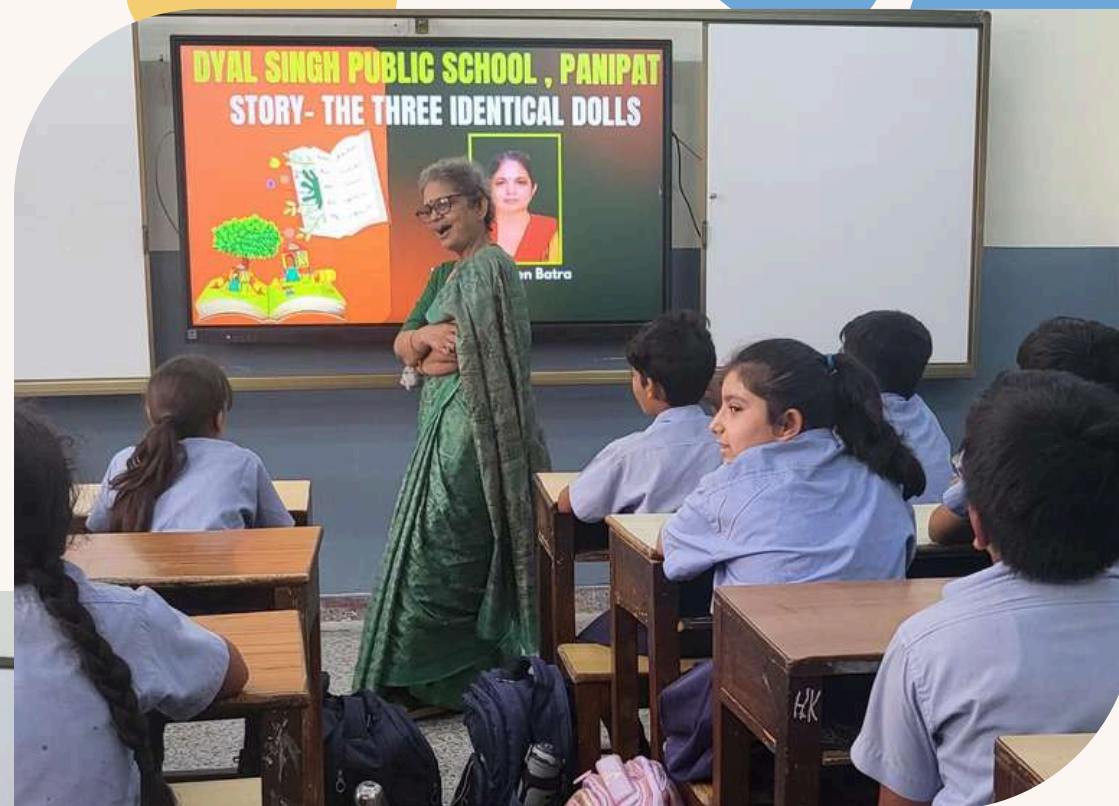
August 14, 2025

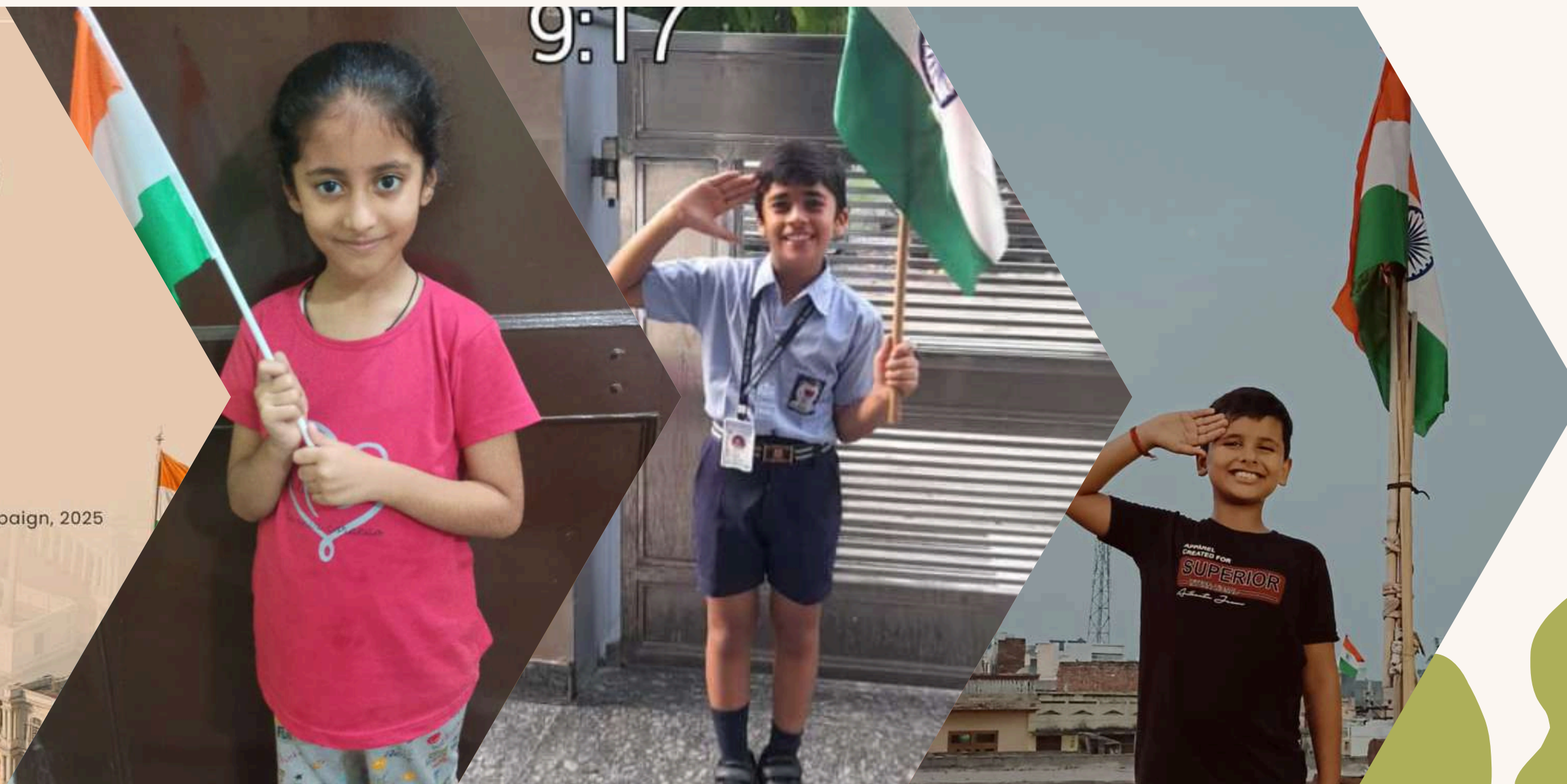

August 18, 2025

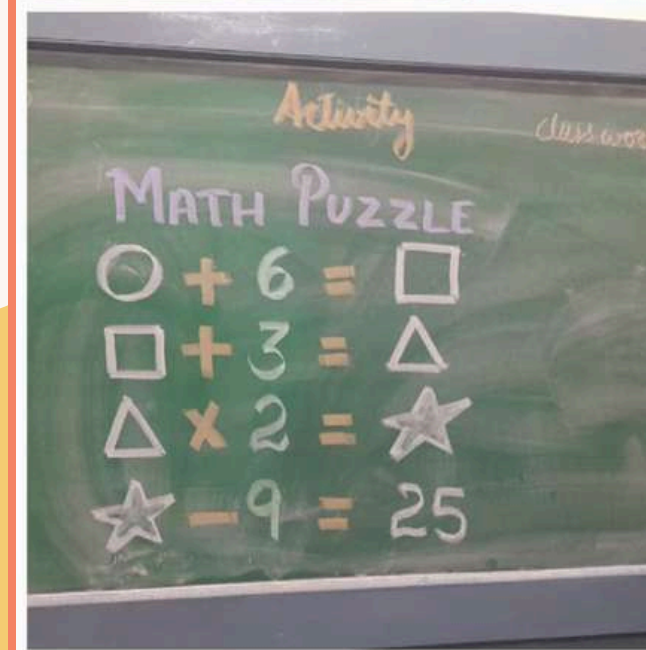
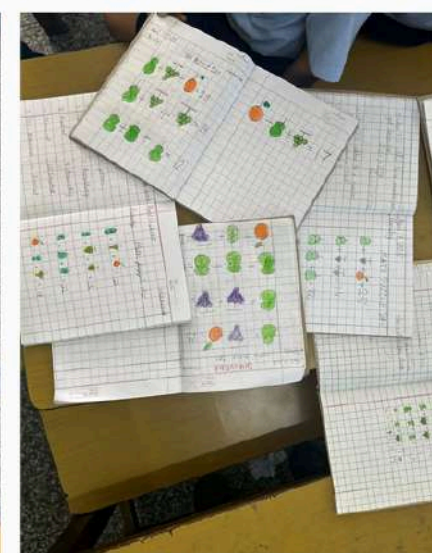
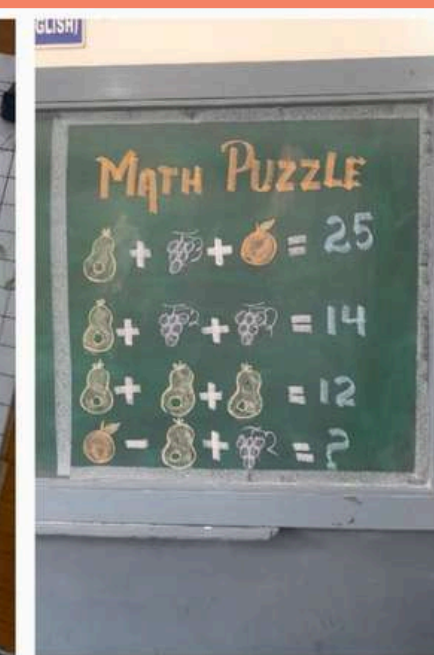
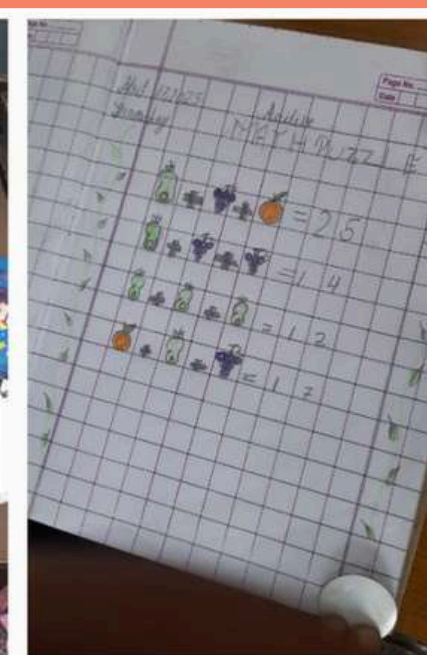
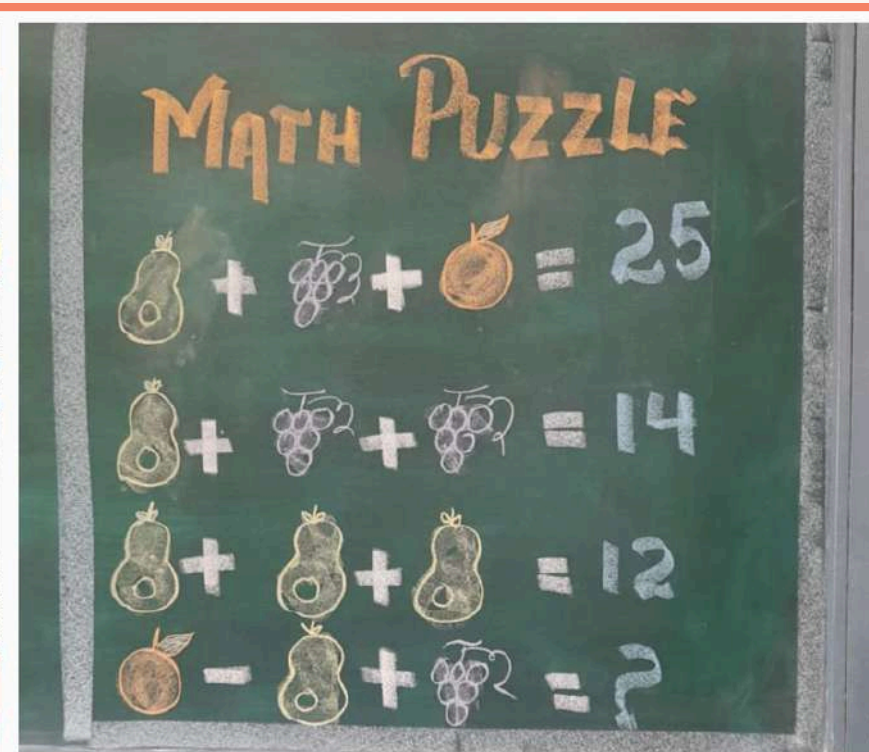

August 18, 2025

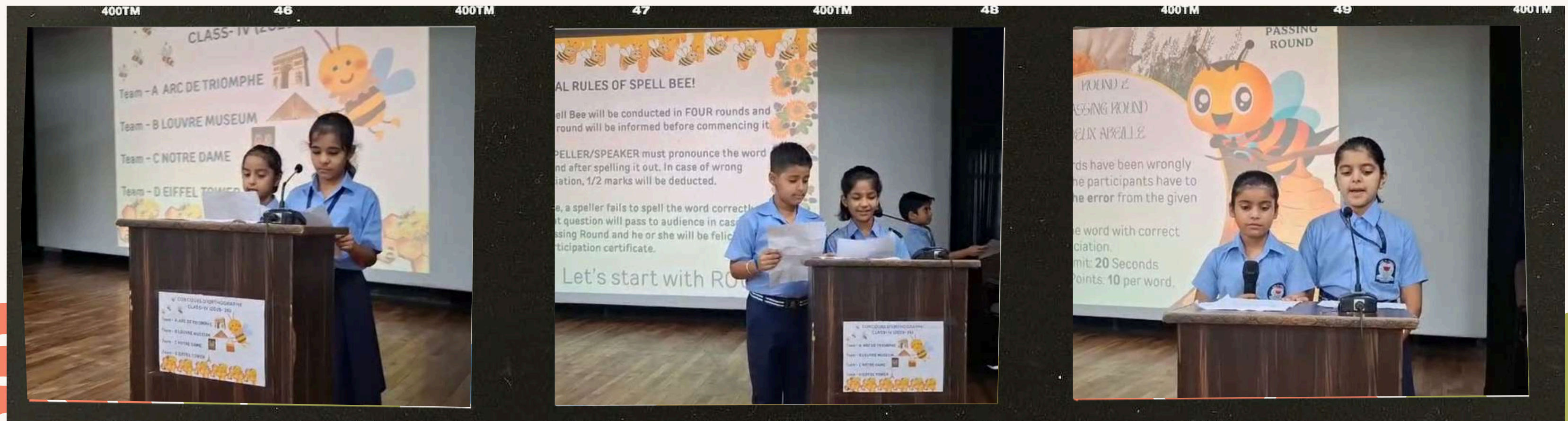

August 29, 2025



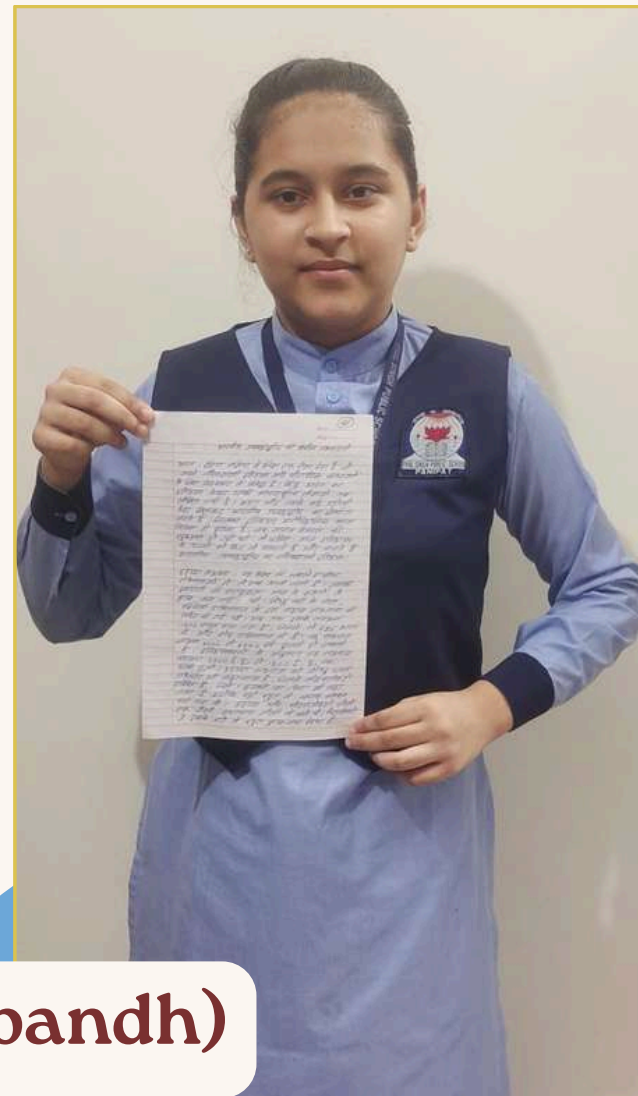

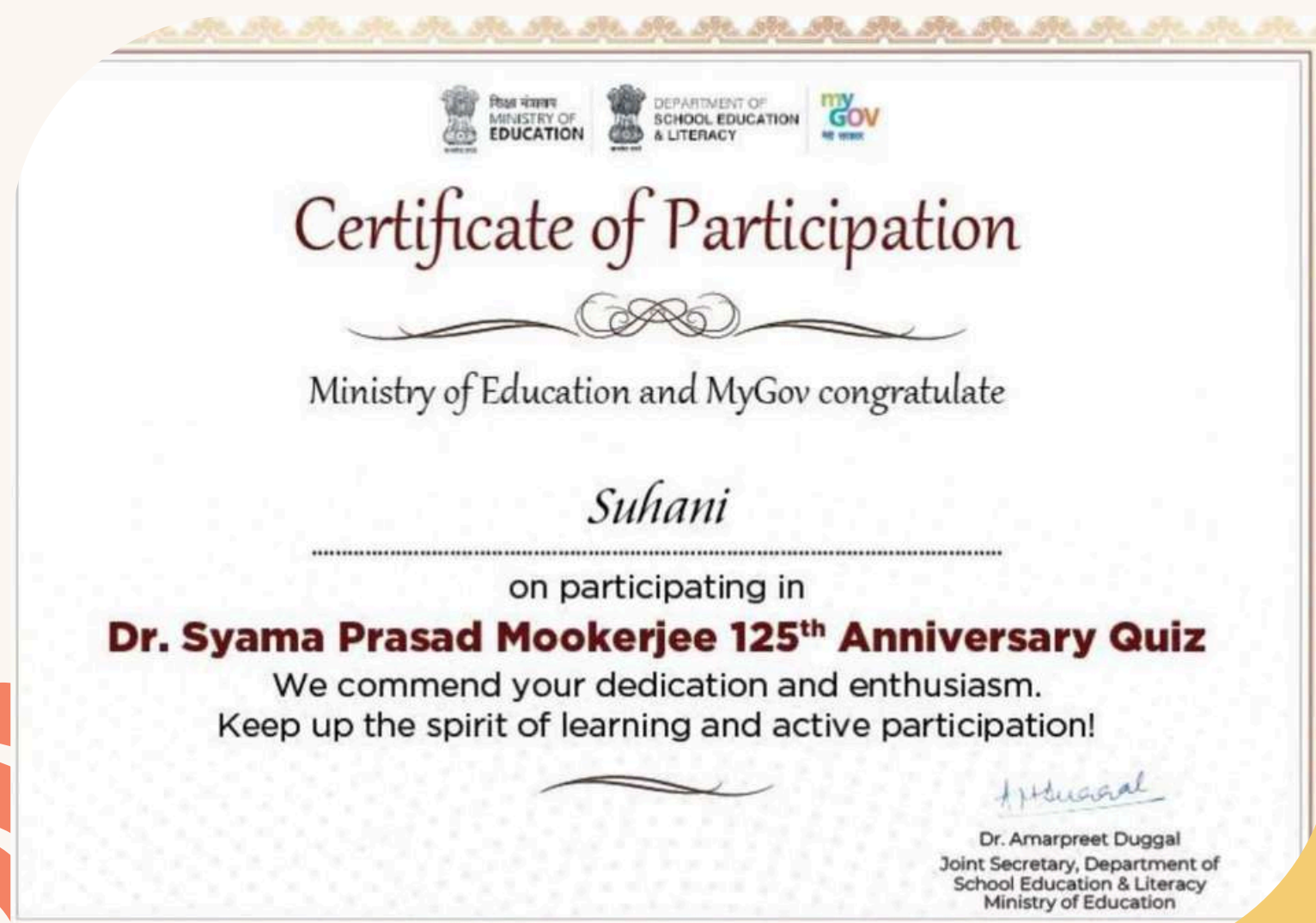

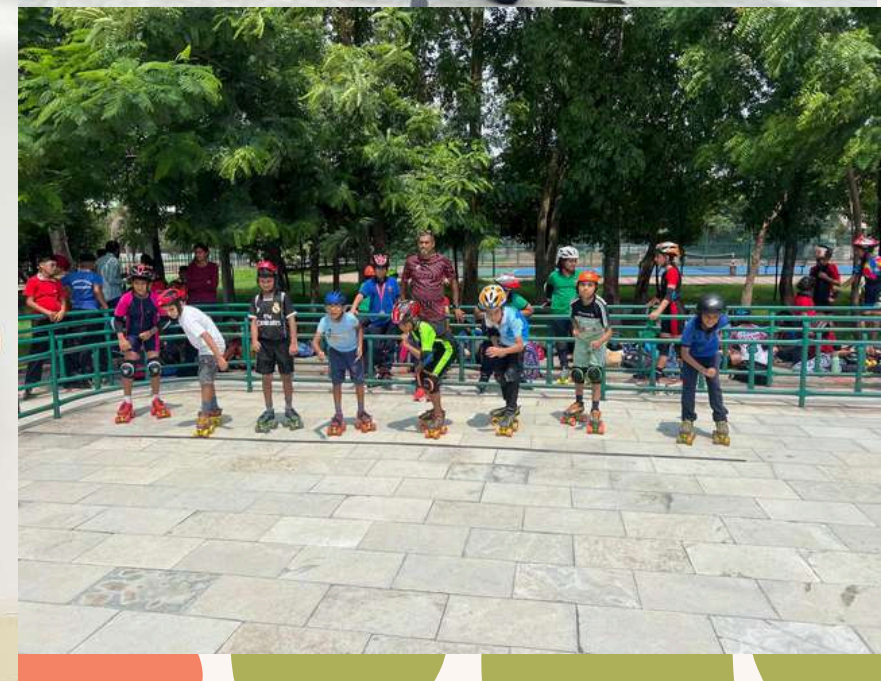
