Career Counselling Workshop: “Career in Merchant Navy”

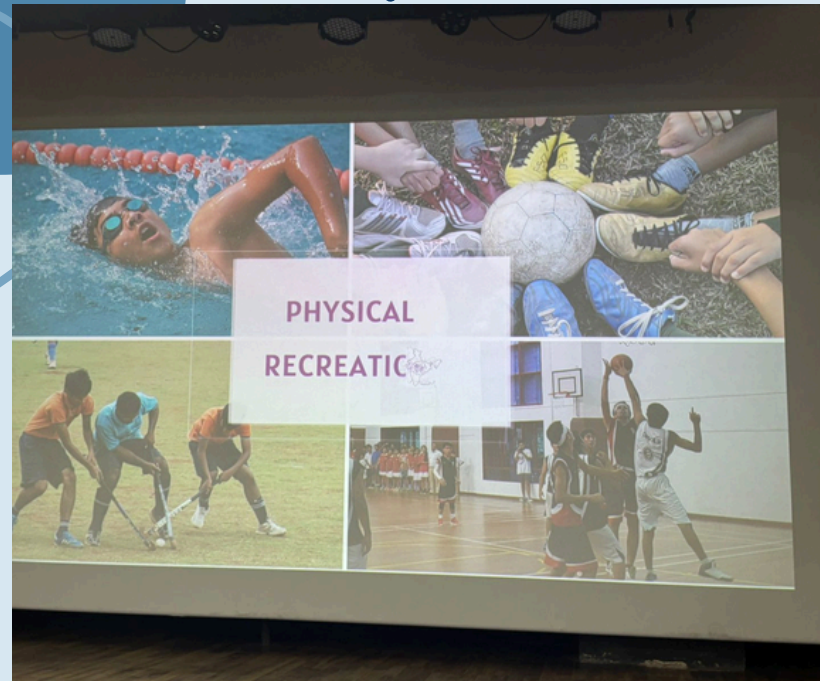
April 10, 2026

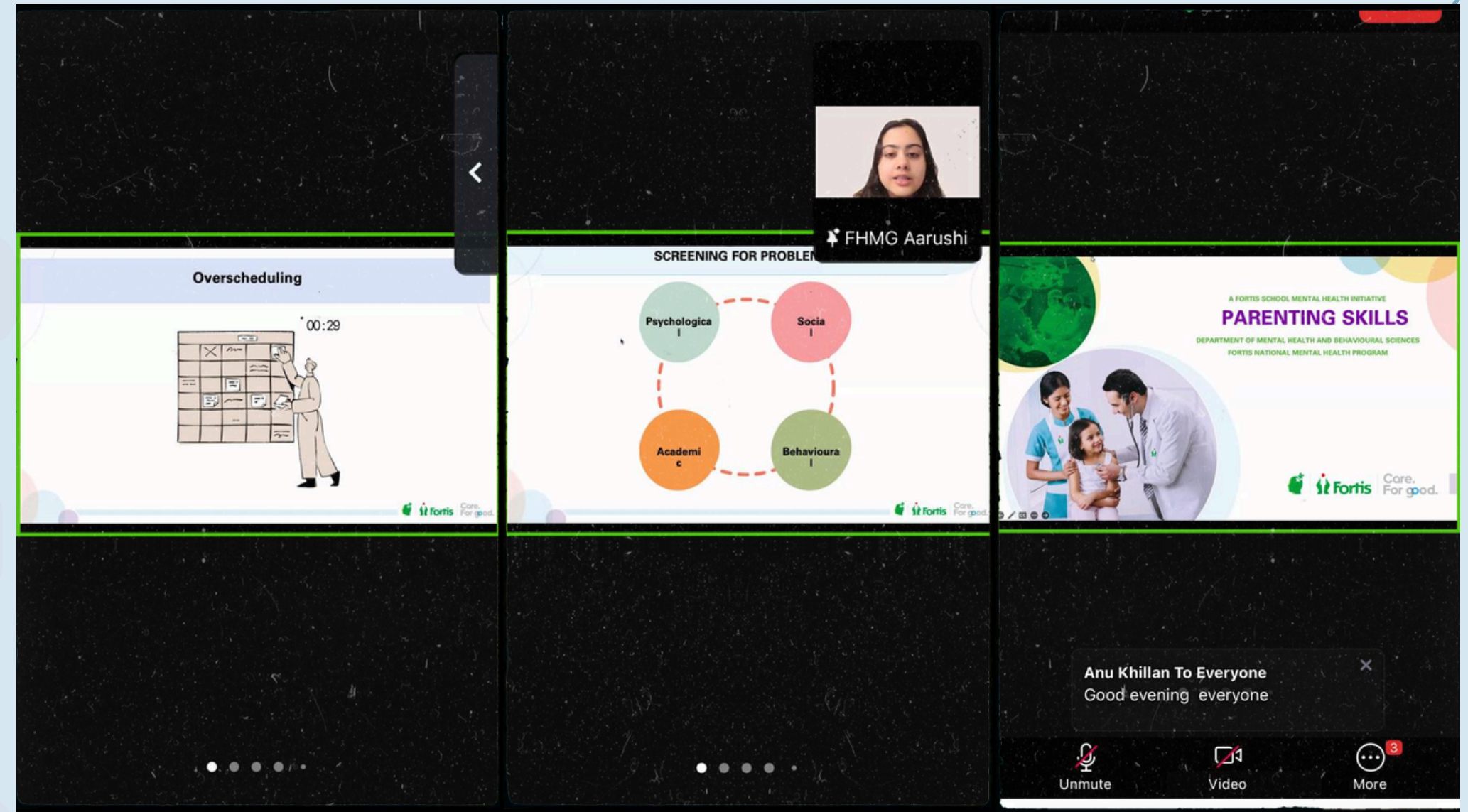


Webinar on “Parenting Skills”

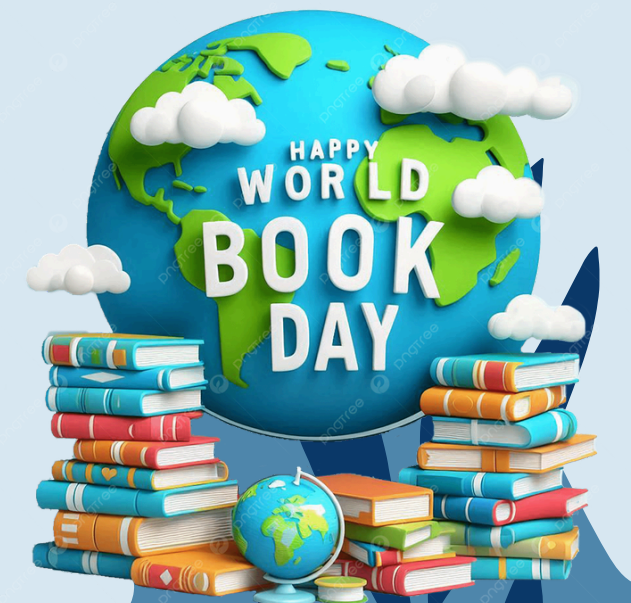
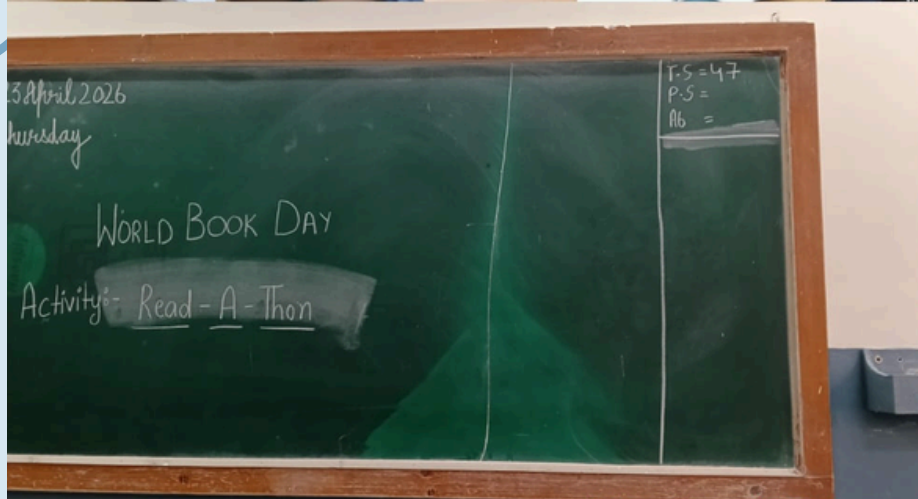

April 25, 2026

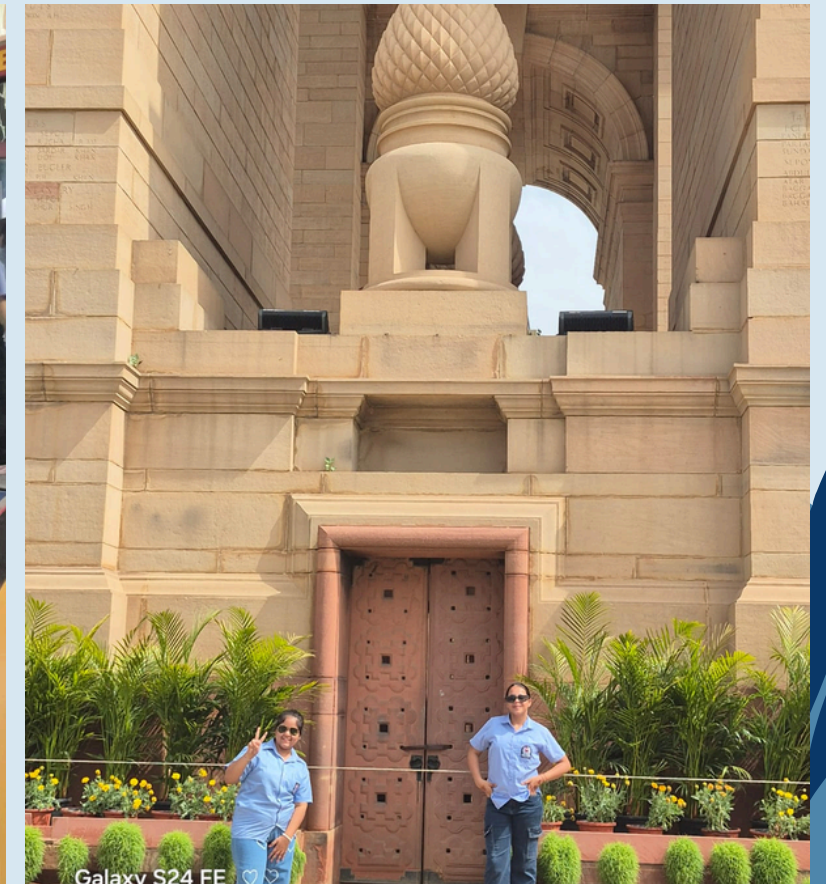
