May 2, 2026

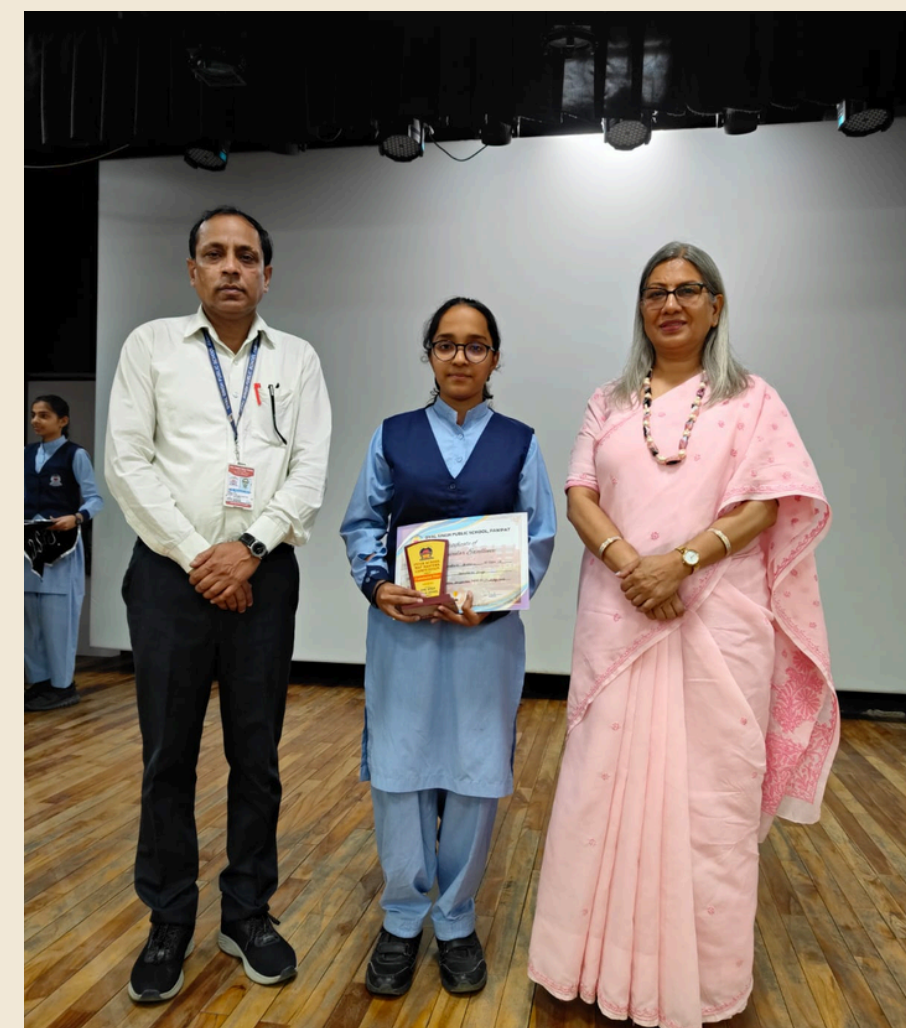

May 4, 2026

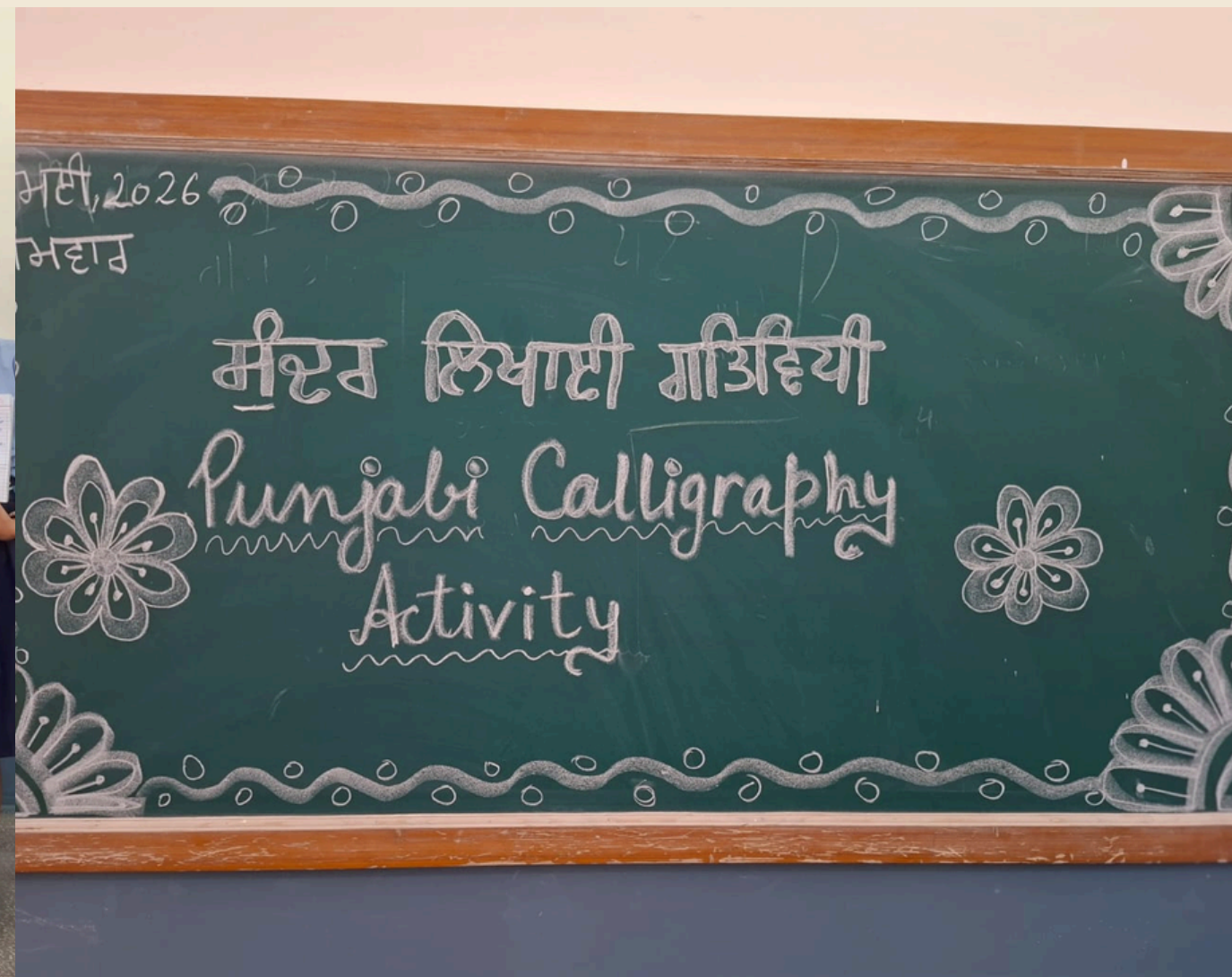
