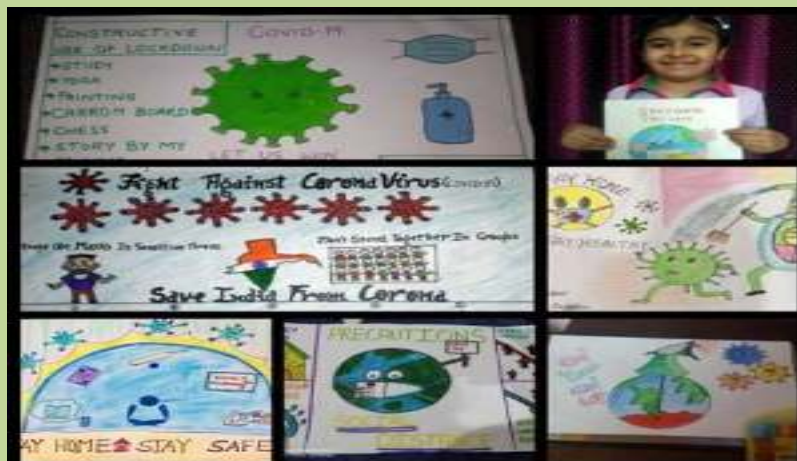
13th April 2020

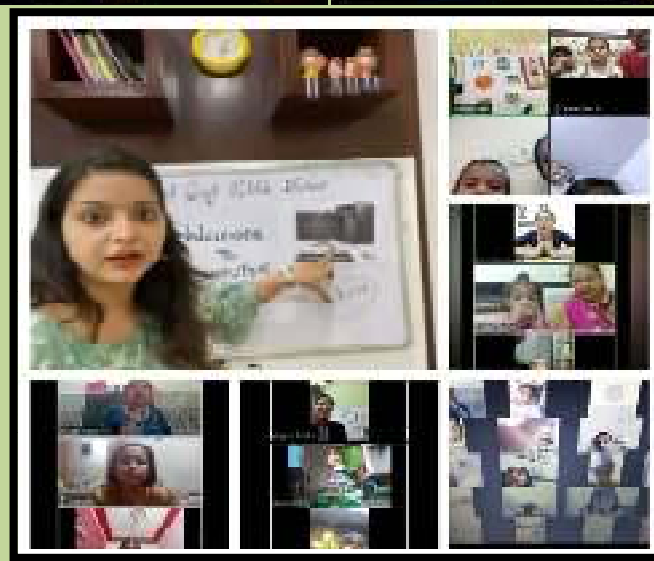
