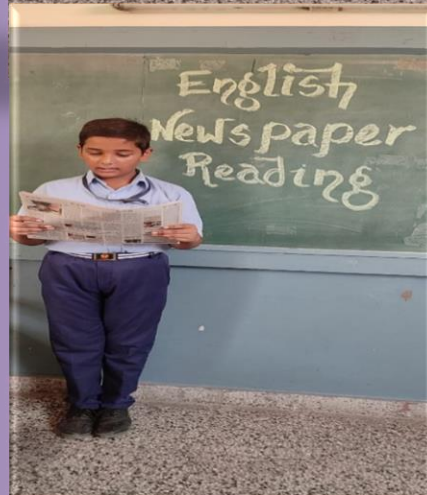
**EARTH DAY CELEBRATION (APRIL 22, 2022)**

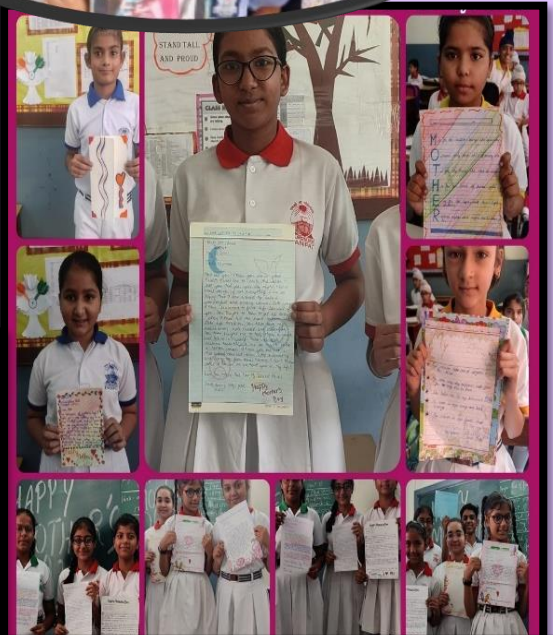

MOTHER'S DAY CELEBRATION (MAY 11, 2022)

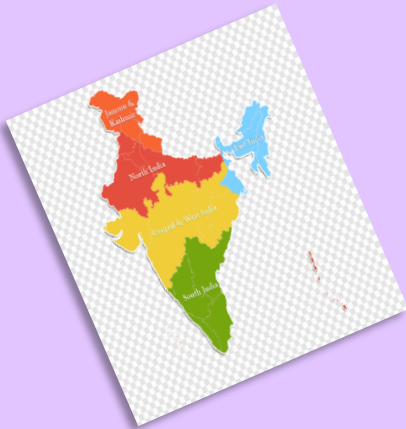

"The bright light of sun holds in the beauty of summer"

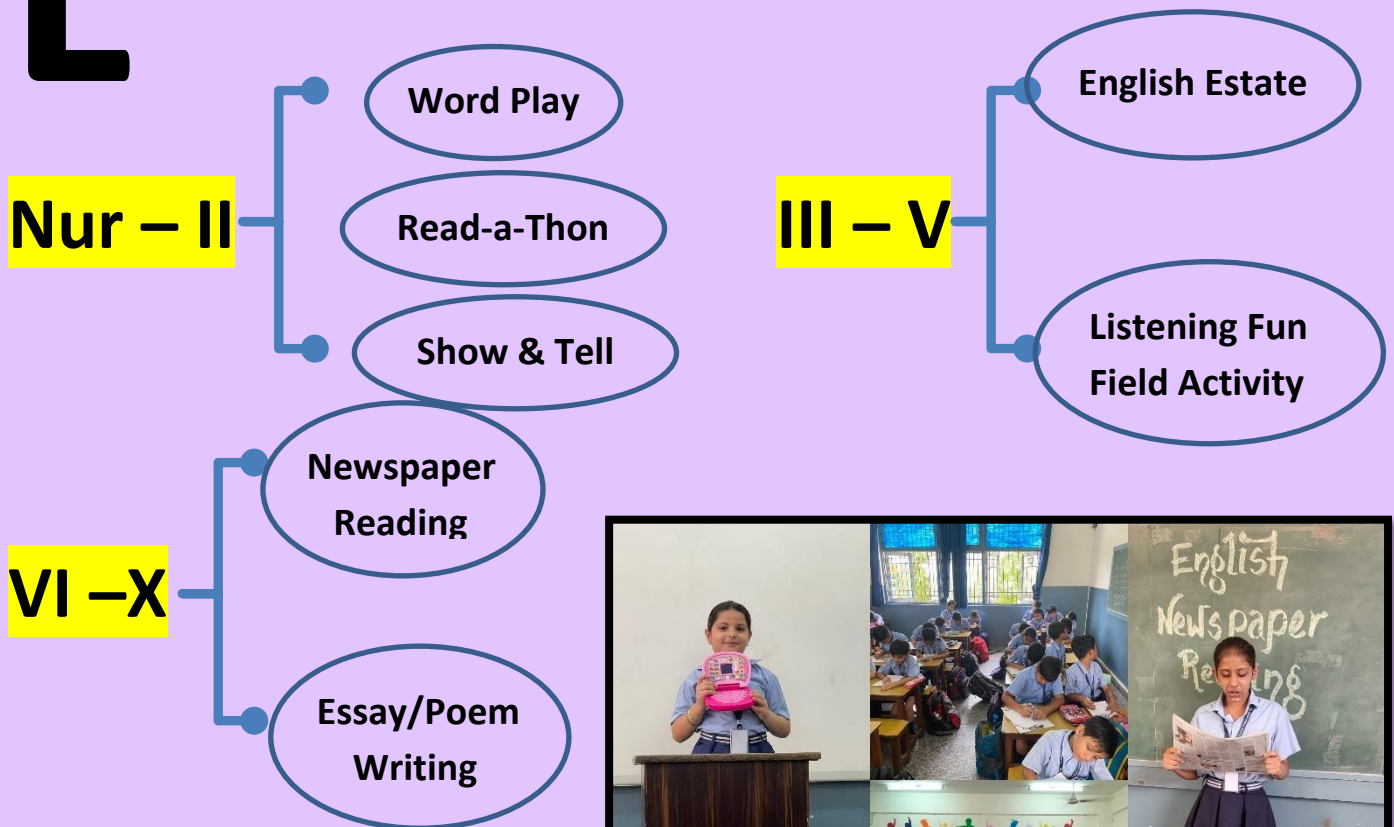

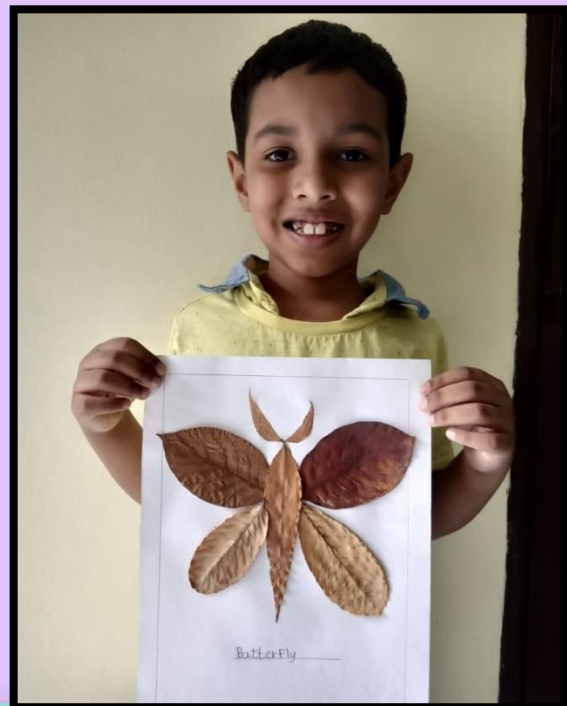


Literary Week was observed to enhance four skills of Learning (Reading, Writing, Speaking & Listening) under the following activities:

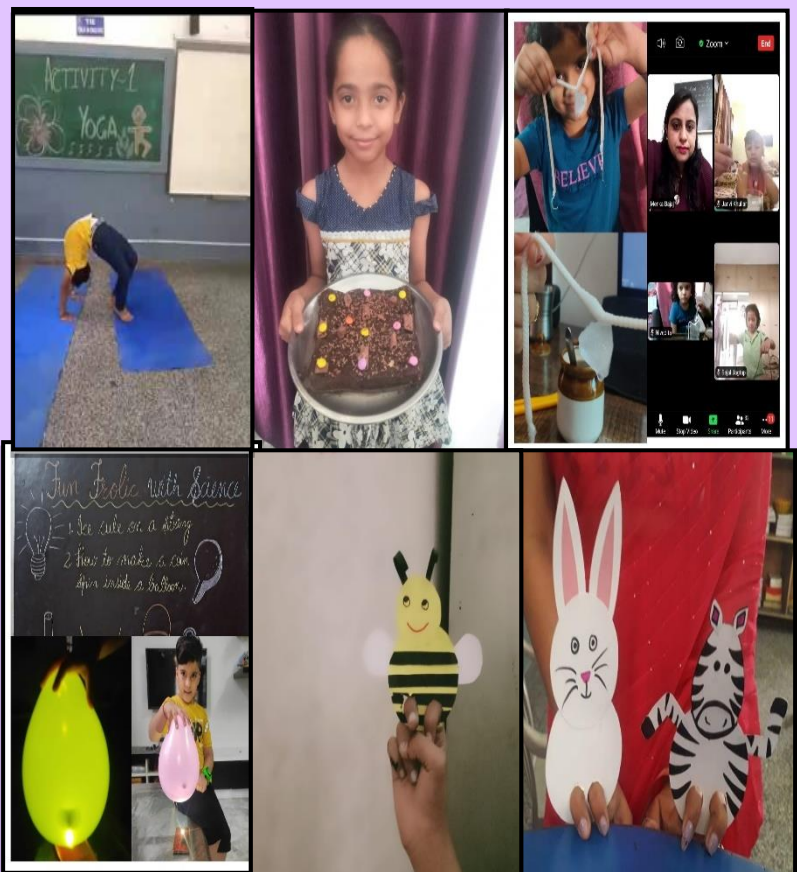

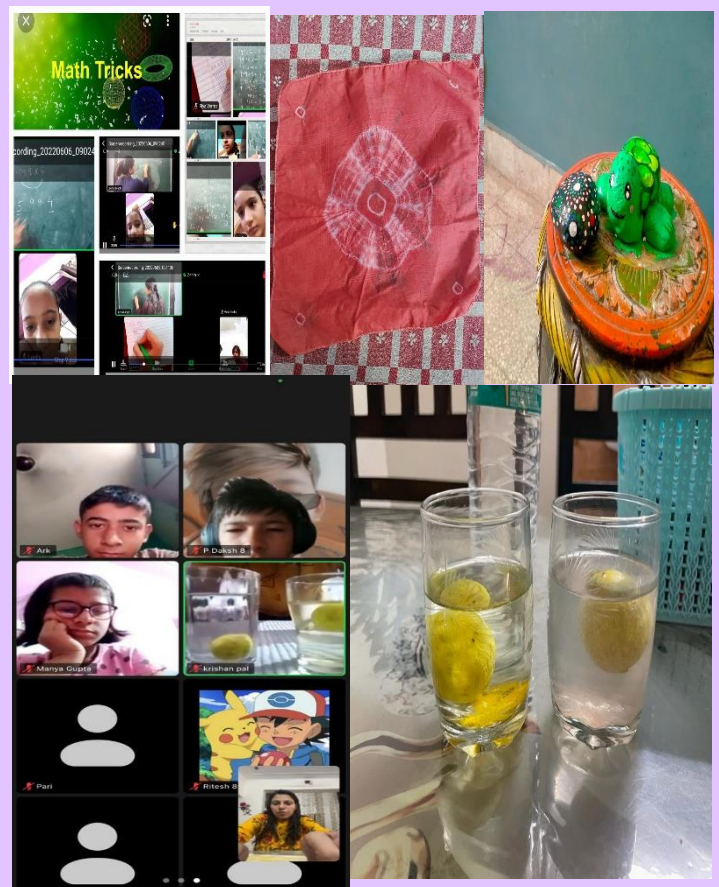

The second group of the students practiced yoga exercises at another historical place Kala Amb - a witness of third battle of Panipat and spread the message of 'Health is Wealth' among people.

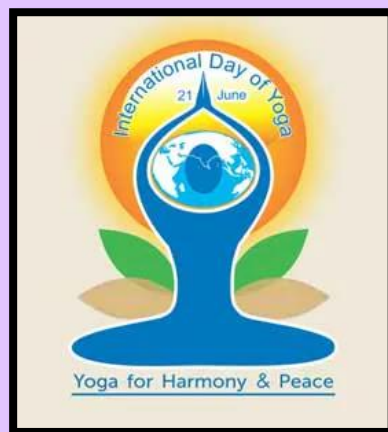


Poster Making Competition was organised on the topic 'Benefits of Yoga in Daily Life'.

International Doctor's Day (JULY 1, 2022)

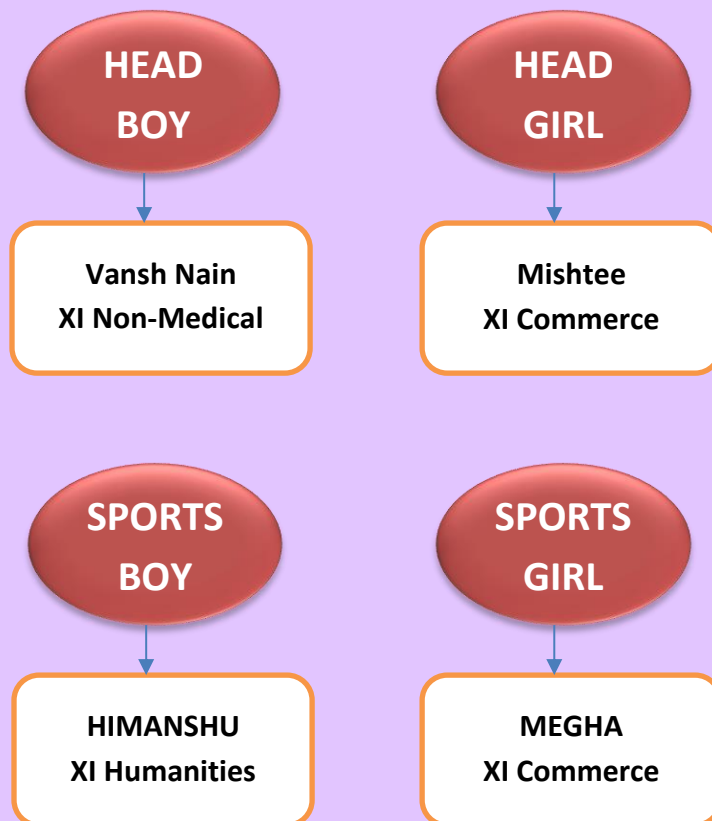

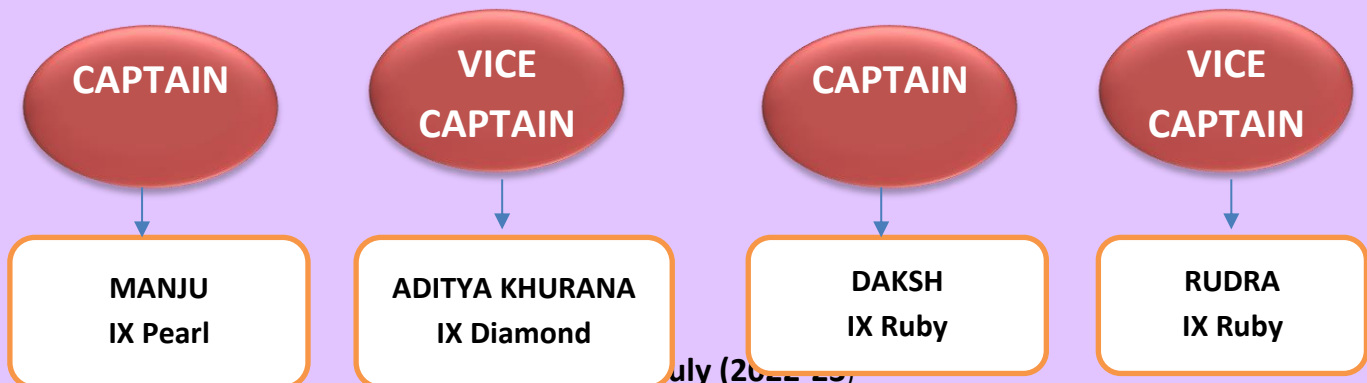
Investiture Ceremony (JULY 6, 2022)

Vision Spring (JULY 11-16, 2022)

VisionSpring Foundation((NGO) conducted eye-screening programme at Dyal Singh Public School, Panipat. This was conducted with gracious recommendation of the Honorary Secretary, Sh. Dhananjaya Kumar Raina due to the adverse impact of 2 years long hours of screen time on students' vision. Under this programme, our 10 teachers got training for preliminary eye check-up in the month of May 2022. Further, the trained teachers did initial check-up of 1796 students of Classes I -X & XII and selected 1007 students for the next round check-up. In the second round, the team of 2 doctors & their 2 assistants from VisionSpring organised eye check-up in our school from July 11, 2022 to July 16, 2022. They did eye check-up of 928 students & found 367 students are in need of spectacles. Further 115 students were referred to doctor for dilation. Maximum students have received spectacles so far & rest will be provided soon. The entire process (eye check-up & provision of spectacles) was free of cost.



Entrepreneurship Promotion Program (JULY 15, 2022)

Entrepreneurship Promotion Program” was organized with the notion ‘Swavalambi Bharat Abhiyan’ in the school premises to make the students aware of the sources of self-employment and income along with education. On this occasion, Mr. Vijay Kalra, Mr. Vinay Chugh, Mr. Himanshu Gakhar, Mr. Rishabh Satija and Mr. Hardik Verma shared their views and motivated students “TO BE A JOB PROVIDERS NOT A JOB SEEKERS”.

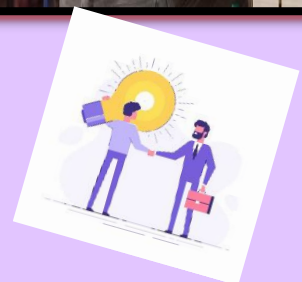

International Justice Day (JULY 18, 2022)

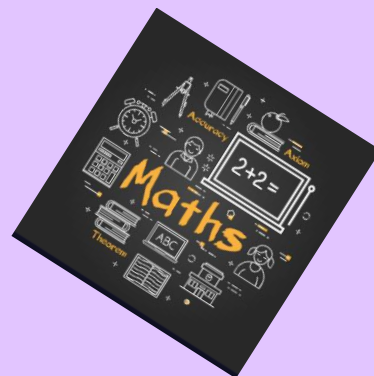

Bus Evacuation Drill was conducted on May 21, 2022 to make children understand how to evacuate or leave the bus quickly and safely through the nearest exit.



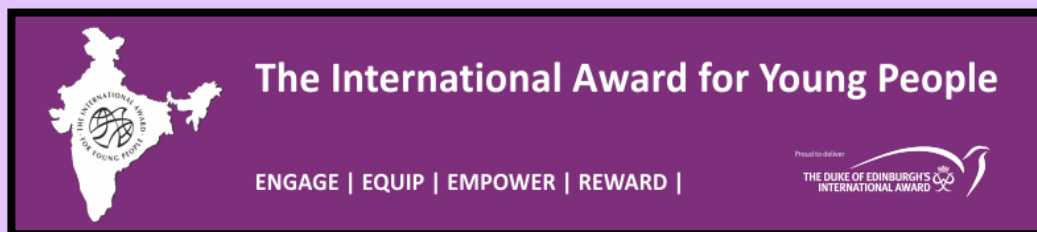


STATE LEVEL COMPETITION AWARD CEREMONY**by****HARYANA CHILD WELFARE SOCIETY**
