1st Position is bagged by Manju (IX), Jasmine (VIII) & Megha (XI) in Senior Youth Basketball Tournament held at Bhiwani



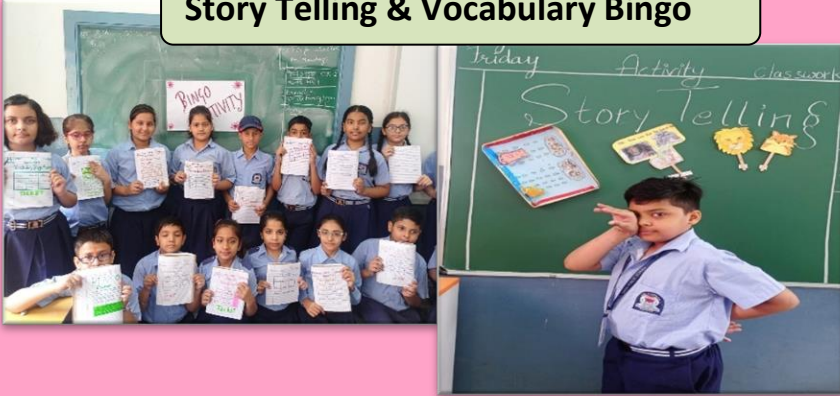
Hunny & Kunal from our school were selected in State Level Baseball Team (U-14) & their team won the match held at Mahendergarh.



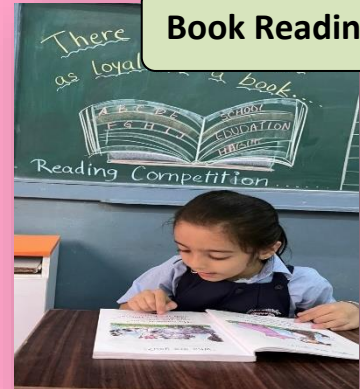

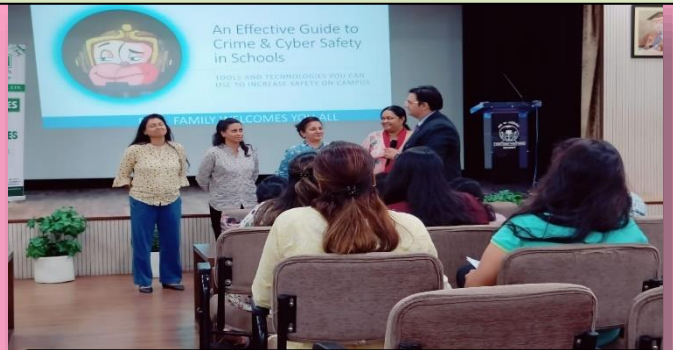
