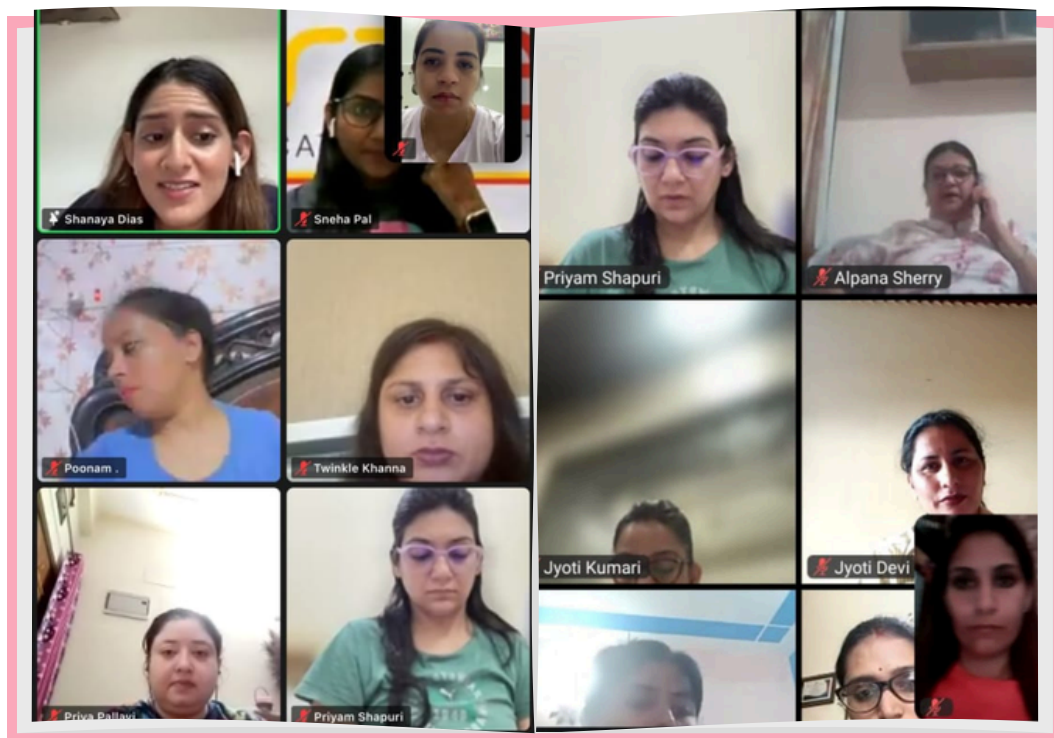

September 1 to 15, 2024



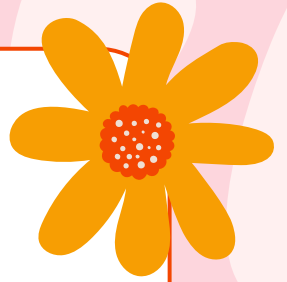

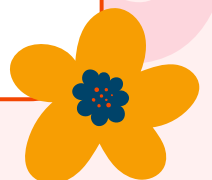
To create awareness, various activities were carried out like -

September 30, 2024







